The picture on the front cover of the Banquet Book is Hezekiah Callahan, while the picture on the Back Cover contains a picture of the adoptive Callahan family. The following account is how the adoption came to pass in the words of Roger and Adriane Callahan.

#### The Adoption Story of Hezekiah Callahan

**First, a little about Adriane and Roger:** We were married in 2010 after a short, one-year courtship. After we were married for a couple of years, we decided to start a family. Easy, right? With that decision, we suffered through about 2 1/2 years of heartache. Placing our burdens on God, we were given hope and peace by the introduction to adoption. We could still parent a child or children!

Our Adoption Journey Begins: We were about to learn a lot about the legalities and mechanics of adoption, but also much more emotionally and spiritually. Roger was aware that an adoption had taken place in the family of a close college friend. Although he was not aware of the specifics, he knew that his friend's sister, Bridget, had placed a newborn child for adoption. Roger hadn't reflected much on Bridget's circumstances, but Roger and Adriane both would soon learn that it was likely one of the hardest, if not bravest decisions that Bridget or any pregnant woman could make. We reached out to Bridget to discuss her adoption experience, and were specifically curious by what means she placed her child for adoption. She introduced us to Bethany Christian Services. This was the agency in which her son, Liam, was placed for adoption. Bethany is an accredited full-service adoption agency and non-profit organization. Bethany envisions a world where every child has a loving family. They do that through adoption, foster care, and pregnancy counseling services. Bethany has a presence in 36 states and in several nations globally. Fortuitously for us, Bethany Christian Services has a presence in Indiana and an office location on the northeast side of Indianapolis. With apprehension and anxiety, we went to an introductory meeting at Bethany of Indianapolis in November of 2012. How blessed we have been because of it!

**Our Education and Application:** Each state has different requirements, but they are mostly similar. In addition, different agencies may have additional requirements. The prevailing perception of what is involved in a home study probably involves an inspection of one's home. That's probably the easiest part of the home study! The paperwork and interviews required assessing the emotional maturity of the prospective parents take a lot of time and effort. Well, we survived the application and home study process and completed the requirements in April of 2013.

A Match: Only after a very short wait, in early May 2013, we received a call from a Bethany counselor that a young, 16-year-old, pregnant girl named Lexi was interested in meeting us. Lexi was 5-months pregnant, and this marked the beginning of the open adoption of our son. Between May and the expected due date in mid-August, we met, talked, or texted with Lexi and her mother several more times; building our relationship.

**Our Son, Hezekiah:** Around the 13th of August, we received the call that Lexi was heading to the hospital to deliver. Then the call came on the 14th that she had given birth to a healthy baby boy! We packed our bags and headed north. On the morning of the 15th there came a call from the Bethany counselor; one that we didn't expect. Lexi was reconsidering her decision to place her child for adoption. We spent the next several hours waiting on a call from the counselor on Lexi's final decision, one that was ultimately and completely hers. After what seemed like an eternity, we received a call to come meet and receive our son. We arrived in the hospital and a nurse and Lexi's mother brought us Hezekiah. Lexi didn't have the physical and emotional strength to see us at that time, but we knew that wouldn't be the end of our relationship.

**Our Adoptive Family:** Hezekiah is now four years old (at this printing). His whole life, Hezekiah has had the acceptance, love, and support of our immediate family, extended family, friends, and community. He is definitely our son, adopting Roger's curiosity and corny, mischievous, and dry sense of humor and Adriane's loving and caring nature. We maintain an open relationship with Hezekiah's birth mother, Lexi, sending her text updates and occasionally visiting with her in person. This is so important for Lexi's continued healing process and reassures her of her decision. It also facilitates Hezekiah being familiar with his adoption story as he grows and matures. Although we don't openly advertise our adoption or infroming others about the blessing of our adoption story if the circumstance allows. This whole experience has given us a closer, more educated and personal perspective on the sanctity of life, especially that of an unborn child. It's hard to imagine what our lives or

what the world would be like if Lexi, in her crisis, had made the decision to abort. It's so important that the "Bethany Christian Services" of the world exist. Ultimately they can exist through the requests and needs of families like ours or the donations from people like you.

### HISTORY OF DAVIESS COUNTY RIGHT TO LIFE INC.

The Daviess County Right To Life Organization was founded in November of 1976 when a small group of people met and decided it was time to form an organization in Daviess County to promote life and work to overturn the Roe vs. Wade Decision which legalized abortion in 1973. A group from Evansville was instrumental in helping our organization get started. Some of the individuals from Daviess County helping to form the organization was Bob Johnson Pastor of Plainville Christian Church along with Ben Ray & Eva Bean, Pastor of Bethany Christian Church, along with Bernie & Alma Wichman, Bill & Josephine Wichman, Margaret Wichman and Vic Hopkins. Bob Johnson became the first president of the organization.

Daviess County Right To Life held its first Banquet in November of 1977 with Wayne Smith as the Speaker, and it was held at the Plainville Lions Club Building in Plainville. We have held a banquet each year since that time, and this has become the highlight of the year for the organization as hundreds of pro-life people come together to renew their effort in the fight against abortion in this country. After the first Banquet was held in Plainville the Banquet was then held at Washington High School for two years and then moved to the Ruritan Building in Montgomery for the next 26 of 27 years with the exception of the Gasthof Restaurant in 1997 before moving to the Simon J. Graber Building which will be the third year. Each time it was moved to accommodate the larger crowds that attend the Banquets.

In 1980 Daviess County RTL was put on the Map when our Banquet was held at the Montgomery Ruritan Building as Dr. Jack Willke and Barb Willke spoke to the nearly 500 who attended this event. The Pro-Life Movement was just coming on the National scene, and National CBS sent a film crew from Chicago to cover this event. The State Right To Life President attended along with Dan Quayle who was running against Senator Birch Bayh made a guest appearance. Film clips from this event were seen on National TV on the CBS Morning Show a day later. The reason the film crew came was to find out why the grass roots pro-life movement was growing so fast and to gage the impact it might have on the 1980 elections, and it did not take long to find out. The film crew could not get over the large crowd that attended in this rural area and was impressed with Southern Indiana Hospitality. Future Banquet Speakers have included major names in the pro-life movement and national figures.

Daviess County Right To Life Organization has been instrumental in helping other Right To Life Groups in our area to form or to give them a helping hand either with donations or with organizational help for their organization. Daviess County Right To Life has been very much involved on the State Level as our local President has not only served as State President but has served on the National Right To Life Board of Directors representing Indiana. Daviess Co. RTL has not only been active in our local area but have been active on the State and Federal level as well. Daviess County Right To Life Organization does not receive funding grants or donations from State or Federal organizations of any kind. The only sources of income for the Organization is from donations from its members and Paper Drives which was started back in 1978 and continues to this day. Daviess Co. RTL opened an office on Main Street in Washington in the early part of 1998, and thru the efforts of then President Donna Gentry opened the Pregnancy Care Center in January of 1999. The Center has now grown where it has its own identity and office staff and serves hundreds of individuals each year. The Pregnancy Care Center and Daviess County Right To Life Organization now share offices in the lower level of the Grace Baptist Church on Troy Road in Washington.

In the 33 years of existence Daviess County Right To Life has only had three Presidents, Bob Johnson from 1976 to 1978, Louis Kavanaugh Jr. from 1978-1995, Donna Gentry from 1995 to 2006 and Louie Kavanaugh Jr. has returned to the office of President in January of 2007 to the present time. Daviess County Right to Life has been very blessed with so many dedicated people who have given so much of their time and effort for the organization. Daviess County RTL has promoted life and worked against abortion thru Radio and Newspaper ads, Booths at Fairs and Montgomery Turkey Trot, put on programs at churches and schools and have lobbied our elected officials to support pro-life legislation. Although we are small in numbers, we have individuals who give it their all for the organization.

Our Organization was hit hard in January of 2011 while honoring Donna Gentry with a Memorial Bench at the site of the First Pregnancy Care Center She suddenly took ill and died a few days later. It was a shock to the organization and to her family and friends who knew her well. She was the founder of the Pregnancy Care Center and served as President of the Daviess Co. RTL for 1995-2006 and worked tireless for the organization. Many projects she undertook was a real shot in the arm not only to the organization but to the pro-life movement. She ran for State Representative on two occasions and nearly upset a long term incumbent in her first try for public office.

Although we have made history in the past, we truly hope the history we make in the future will be that all lives of the unborn are protected from conception to natural death. May God Bless our all of us in our work and Bless our Country!

#### Bethany Christian Church, Near Montgomery, Site Where Daviess Co. RTL Held Meeting for Many Years



The picture above of the old Bethany Christian Church west of Montgomery on Hwy 50 was taken just two days before the church was taken down. This was the site where Daviess County Right To Life held its meetings for many years. After the first meeting was held at the YMCA in Washington the meetings were moved to Bethany Church in 1976. Ben Bean who was the Pastor there for over 40 years invited the Right To Life to hold their meetings at the church and Ben Bean became the Vice President and held that position for many years. Ben & Eva Bean were very hospitable to the Right to Life members, and many lasting friendships were made because of Ben's invitation to the Right To Life.

When Donna Gentry took over as President, and the Pregnancy Care Center was started in January of 1999, the meetings were then moved to the Main Street location of the PCC on Main Street in Washington. After the building sold, the Right To Life & the PCC were moved to 608 West Walnut Street in September of 2004. In November of 2008 the Right To Life and the PCC moved to the present location on 705 Troy Road in the lower level of the Grace Baptist Church. They are very pleased with the location and the facilities.

It was sad to see the church taken down, but the membership of the church had grown so much they built a new church on highway 57 south of Washington. The old church was taken down on Monday August 11, and it took several days for the clean up. The old site of Bethany Christian Church will always have a soft spot in our hearts, and we will remember Ben & Eva Bean and the many hours we worked together on the many functions for Daviess RTL and the Support they gave us. We will always remember those dedicated members who worked so hard to start Daviess County Right To Life, especially the Wichman Family who are too nummerous to name here. We will always remember those early days and thank those who gave so much in the fight against Abortion. God Bless Them!

#### Paper Drives Continue for Right to Life Organization

Mike Wichman who is now in charge of the Right To Life Paper Drives took over after his Dad Bernie Wichman got sick in 2002 and passed away. Bernie Wichman took care of the Paper Drives from the beginning back in 1978 until his health failed, and Mike, his son, took up the torch. Mike has always helped at the drives and along with his brothers Chuck and Steve Wichman were always dependable help for the drives. In fact, the the Wichman Family has always been well represented at the Paper Drives. Beginning with Bernie and his brothers Bill and Bob and Bernie's children and other members of the Wichman Family, we could not have done it without them. Bernie's wife Alma always made the sandwiches and got the soft drinks for the crew. When Alma got sick and was unable to do it anymore, their daughter Mary Jo "Wichman" Sellers took over and does it to this day. Mary Jo was also the Treasurer for the Daviess Co. Right To Life for many years and has continued the tradation of the Wichman family helping out at these paper drives. Many of the Wichman Grandchildren have helped at one time or another and continue to do so to this day.

The Paper Drives started back in 1978 at the parking lot next to Washington Catholic School, then moved to old 3-D Plaza, then to the old Big Blue Parking lot and then to Old K-Mart Parking lot, to the Fastenal lot and now back to the Tractor Supply Parking Lot (Old K-Mart Lot.) Over the years the Paper Drives would fill a full semi in one day, but now because of the cut back in newsprint it may take two drives or more to fill a semi-trailor. In the last several years the Right To Life has started recycling alumium cans, and this has proved to be very benificial to the group. At one time the Paper Drives also took magazines, but we do not have an outlet to sell them and that was discontinued years ago.

The Paper Drives are held the first Sat. of the even months of the year with the main location at the Tractor Supply Parking lot in Washington. We have pickup points at Plainville, Odon, Elnora, and Montgomery. Over the years it is estimated we have saved a thousand or more tons of paper from going to the landfill and in the process helped the local RTL Organization to promote life. At one point the Paper Drives were the main source of income for the organization but now our donations have increased and have helped the organization to do even more in the battle against abortion. We thank everyone for their support of these drives and hope you will continue to recxycle.

#### Winner of 2017 Donna Gentry Memorial Scholarship The Following Essay was written by Grace Bassler

#### "What is happening to America because of abortion?"

America was created on the founding principle that all are created equal. Americans have always strived to treat everyone with a uniform degree of dignity and respect. However, time after time we have fallen short of this goal. The *Roe v*. *Wade* Supreme Court decision is an example of an occasion in which the nation failed to treat people equally. Since this decision there have been nearly sixty million abortions performed in America. This overwhelming number will only continue to grow until the people of this nation choose to treat all humans equally.

Since the infamous *Roe v. Wade* decision, abortion has been one of the most disputed political topics in America. People from all over the nation disagree on when to consider babies human and give them human rights. Many pro-choice advocates simply refuse to be persuaded by the compelling scientific evidence that life begins at the moment of conception.

When *Roe v. Wade* was decided in 1973, there was very little scientific evidence to support the pro-life platform that life begins at conception. However, in the past few decades there have been incredible strides in our scientific knowledge of life. At the moment of conception, the child possesses all forty-six chromosomes of his parents' combined DNA. The child's genetic makeup is already in place and will remain the same for the rest of his life.

Additionally, scientists have identified the following seven characteristics of life: responsiveness to the environment, growth and change, the ability to reproduce, a regulated metabolism and oxygen flow, maintaining homeostasis, composed of cells, and the capacity to pass traits onto offspring. These are the characteristics that biologists use to determine if something is a living creature. A human fetus possesses all seven of these characteristics at conception. Clearly, life is present from the moment the child is conceived.

Over the past several years, a plethora of medical professionals have concluded that life begins at conception. Dr. Bernard N. Nathanson, an internationally known obstetrician and gynecologist, was once one of the biggest pro-choice advocates in the nation. For years, he campaigned in support of abortion while directing one of the largest abortion clinics in the world. After directing the performance of over sixty thousand abortions, Nathanson began to realize that human life was indeed present in the womb. In his book, "The Hand of God: A Journey from Death to Life by the Abortion Doctor Who Changed His Mind," Nathanson wrote, "For the first time, we could really see the human fetus, measure it, observe it, watch it, and indeed bond with it and love it." The new scientific technologies of fetoscopy and ultrasound convinced Nathanson of the presence of life beginning at conception. The persuasive scientific and medical evidence of life leaves no room for arguments against it.

The increase of abortions in America has led to a decline of supportive families. Abortion has become commonplace in society as Americans have begun to respect human life less. If Americans extended human rights to *all* humans, this would be a much more peaceful and prosperous nation.
