

2024 Right to Life Banquet Speaker

Dr. John Bruchalski, Former Abortionist!



Daviess/Pike and Martin County Right to Life Groups would like to welcome Dr. John Bruchalski, Former Abortionist, as the speaker for the 2024 Right to Life Banquet.

Dr. Bruchalski earned his medical degree from the University of South Alabama College of Medicine in 1987 and completed his OB/GYN residency at Eastern Virginia Medical Center and the Jones Institute for Reproductive Medicine in Norfolk, Virginia in 1991 and was board certified in 1993. He began his career in obstetrics and

gynecology practicing the full range of reproductive medicine.

He experienced a profound conversion of heart following a live birth during a late-term abortion procedure and resolved to practice life-affirming medicine that supported women, children, and their families.

As he explains it, "I came to see that true health care for women is not about rights, but relationships—not about limits, but about love and mercy."

In 1994, Dr. Bruchalski and his wife, Carolyn, founded Tepeyac OB/GYN in Northern Virginia, a pro-life practice that offers a variety of care options to women regardless of ability to pay.

In 2000 Dr. Bruchalski established Divine Mercy Care, a non-profit foundation that raises funds to support charitable care at Tepeyac OB/GYN. In its almost 30 years of operation, Tepeyac OB/GYN has delivered more than 10,000 children, with nearly 30 percent of their mothers receiving financial aid from Divine Mercy Care. Dr. Bruchalski's memoir entitled Two Patients was published by Ignatius Press in 2022.

The picture on the front cover of the Banquet Book is the Adoptive Child of Rob and Megan Abel. The picture on the Back Cover contains a Family Picture of all the Abel Family. The following account is how the adoptions came to pass in the words of the Abel Family.

When people talk about the best day of their lives, they often refer to a wedding day or the day their child was born. For us, the absolute best day of our lives was the day our family officially and legally became complete. The day the four of us finally shared the same last name. The day we had two daughters. The day Violet became a big sister. The day Renlee became a little sister. This day was February 15, 2024.

Our lives first crossed in 2009. Two young college kids. We became good friends and maintained that friendship for four years. We started dating in 2013 and married in 2016. Rob had cancer during our friendship years. This kept him from being able to biologically become a father. Despite this, we knew God's plan for us was to be parents. We had researched multiple options, foster care, adoption, and infertility treatments.

At the end of 2017 we started our fertility journey. This allowed us to have our first blessing, Violet in October of 2018. We love being her parents. She is such a joy to us.

We had discussed growing our family again. This time we wanted to foster to adopt. We became licensed foster parents in October of 2022. We lived the foster life. The highs were high and the lows were low. Approximately 8 months in, we decided we needed to provide healthier environment for Violet. She struggled with the unknown, as did we but had a deeper understanding for the situation.

In May of 2023 we made the decision to return to the fertility route. We completed our testing and while waiting for results we got a text we never expected. Friday, July 21st our licensing coordinator, through our foster agency, said we were chosen for an interview for a safe haven baby. She had no details other than they would contact us Monday to schedule. That weekend we discussed and were agreeable to the interview but didn't have a lot of faith in it amounting to anything. Surely 10s or 100s of people were chosen.

On Monday July 24, Rob's birthday, we got a call to see if we would be interested in scheduling an interview for a safe haven baby that had been surrendered. We said yes, and scheduled the appointment for that Thursday. While on the phone, I (Megan) decided I would ask a few questions. We found out it was for a baby girl that was just 11 days old (2 days old at surrender). The next question I asked got me so nervous and excited. I could barely function. I asked how many families were being interviewed. I was informed two, TWO. Just us and one other family! We actually had a chance. And a 50/50 chance.

It was a LONG 3 days. Very few knew of our interview.

Thursday morning involved a very anxious 3 hour drive. We arrived and interviewed first. We were in a room with approximately 10 individuals. The interview lasted about an hour. They asked us many questions. We asked many questions. We saw a picture of this beautiful baby girl. Before completing our interview we were told we likely wouldn't hear anything until Monday but thereafter things would move quickly. I asked if once they made a decision they could let us know so we were able to prepare our house, our jobs, our family. We left feeling like we did well. We were open and very honest with our answers but unaware if we were the people they were looking for.

We ate lunch and started the 3 hour drive home. We got about 30 minutes down the road and my phone rang. It wasn't a number I was familiar with but the area code indicated from the area of our interview. We felt sure they were calling to tell us we were not chosen. But instead, we were. We were chosen to be this baby's parent, her family. To say we were speechless is understatement. Disbelief, excitement, happiness and nervousness all hit at once.

Just 4 days later, August 1st our baby came home at just 16 days old. Our hearts and house felt full. This sweet baby was the missing piece to our family. We all bonded together. Violet had her baby sister and she rocked the big sister role. Renlee was a great baby and was rocking the baby life!

When we got our forever family day we were excited. It seemed to take forever but life was busy.

The day was beyond perfect. We were surrounded by more than 30 friends and family (most traveling 3+ hours to support us). We were also joined by many new friends we met throughout the journey including the firefighter that received Renlee from the safe haven box. Renlee had stolen his heart in a second, he will forever be our friend.

Our DCS team and her CASA we had weekly communication and monthly visits with.

Our forever family day, February 15, 2024 will forever be our favorite day.

We remain eternally grateful to God and to the fact that this mother chose adoption, not abortion.

HISTORY OF DAVIESS COUNTY RIGHT TO LIFE INC.

The Daviess County Right To Life Organization was founded in November of 1976 when a small group of people met and decided it was time to form an organization in Daviess County to promote life and work to overturn the Roe vs. Wade Decision which legalized abortion in 1973. A group from Evansville was instrumental in helping our organization get started. Some of the individuals from Daviess County helping to form the organization was Bob Johnson Pastor of Plainville Christian Church along with Ben Ray & Eva Bean, Pastor of Bethany Christian Church, along with Bernie & Alma Wichman, Bill & Josephine Wichman, Margaret Wichman and Vic Hopkins. Bob Johnson became the first president of the organization.

Daviess County Right To Life held its first Banquet in November of 1977 with Wayne Smith as the Speaker, and it was held at the Plainville Lions Club Building in Plainville. We have held a banquet each year since that time, and this has become the highlight of the year for the organization as hundreds of pro-life people come together to renew their effort in the fight against abortion in this country. After the first Banquet was held in Plainville the Banquet was then held at Washington High School for two years and then moved to the Ruritan Building in Montgomery for the next 26 of 27 years with the exception of the Gasthof Restaurant in 1997 before moving to the Simon J. Graber Building which will be the third year. Each time it was moved to accommodate the larger crowds that attend the Banquets.

In 1980 Daviess County RTL was put on the Map when our Banquet was held at the Montgomery Ruritan Building as Dr. Jack Willke and Barb Willke spoke to the nearly 500 who attended this event. The Pro-Life Movement was just coming on the National scene, and National CBS sent a film crew from Chicago to cover this event. The State Right To Life President attended along with Dan Quayle who was running against Senator Birch Bayh made a guest appearance. Film clips from this event were seen on National TV on the CBS Morning Show a day later. The reason the film crew came was to find out why the grass roots pro-life movement was growing so fast and to gage the impact it might have on the 1980 elections, and it did not take long to find out. The film crew could not

get over the large crowd that attended in this rural area and was impressed with Southern Indiana Hospitality. Future Banquet Speakers have included major names in the pro-life movement and national figures.

Daviess County Right To Life Organization has been instrumental in helping other Right To Life Groups in our area to form or to give them a helping hand either with donations or with organizational help for their organization. Daviess County Right To Life has been very much involved on the State Level as our local President has not only served as State President but has served on the National Right To Life Board of Directors representing Indiana. Daviess Co. RTL has not only been active in our local area but have been active on the State and Federal level as well. Daviess County Right To Life Organization does not receive funding grants or donations from State or Federal organizations of any kind. The only sources of income for the Organization is from donations from its members and Paper Drives which was started back in 1978 and continues to this day. Daviess Co. RTL opened an office on Main Street in Washington in the early part of 1998, and thru the efforts of then President Donna Gentry opened the Pregnancy Care Center in January of 1999. The Center has now grown where it has its own identity and office staff and serves hundreds of individuals each year. The Pregnancy Care Center and Daviess County Right To Life Organization now share offices in the lower level of the Grace Baptist Church on Troy Road in Washington.

In the years of existence Daviess County Right To Life has only had three Presidents, Bob Johnson from 1976 to 1978, Louis Kavanaugh Jr. from 1978-1995, Donna Gentry from 1995 to 2006 and Louie Kavanaugh Jr. has returned to the office of President in January of 2007 to the present time. Daviess County Right to Life has been very blessed with so many dedicated people who have given so much of their time and effort for the organization. Daviess County RTL has promoted life and worked against abortion thru Radio and Newspaper ads, Booths at Fairs and Montgomery Turkey Trot, put on programs at churches and schools and have lobbied our elected officials to support pro-life legislation. Although we are small in numbers, we have individuals who give it their all for the organization.

Our Organization was hit hard in January of 2011 while honoring Donna Gentry with a Memorial Bench at the site of the First Pregnancy Care Center She suddenly took ill and died a few days later. It was a shock to the organization and to her family and friends who knew her well. She was the founder of the Pregnancy Care Center and served as President of the Daviess Co. RTL for 1995-2006 and worked tireless for the organization. Many projects she undertook was a real shot in the arm not only to the organization but to the pro-life movement. She ran for State Representative on two occasions and nearly upset a long term incumbent in her first try for public office.

Although we have made history in the past, we truly hope the history we make in the future will be that all lives of the unborn are protected from conception to natural death. May God Bless our all of us in our work and Bless our Country!

Bethany Christian Church, Near Montgomery, Site Where Daviess Co. RTL Held Meeting for Many Years



The picture above of the old Bethany Christian Church west of Montgomery on Hwy 50 was taken just two days before the church was taken down. This was the site where Daviess County Right To Life held its meetings for many years. After the first meeting was held at the YMCA in Washington the meetings were moved to Bethany Church in 1976. Ben Bean who was the Pastor there for over 40 years invited the Right To Life to hold their meetings at the church and Ben Bean became the Vice President and held that position for many years. Ben & Eva Bean were very hospitable to the Right to Life members, and many lasting friendships were made because of Ben's invitation to the Right To Life.

When Donna Gentry took over as President, and the Pregnancy Care Center was started in January of 1999, the meetings were then moved to the Main Street location of the PCC on Main Street in Washington. After the building sold, the Right To Life & the PCC were moved to 608 West Walnut Street in September of 2004. In November of 2008 the Right To Life and the PCC moved to the present location on 705 Troy Road in the lower level of the Grace Baptist Church. They are very pleased with the location and the facilities.

It was sad to see the church taken down, but the membership of the church had grown so much they built a new church on highway 57 south of Washington. The old church was taken down on Monday August 11, and it took several days for the clean up. The old site of Bethany Christian Church will always have a soft spot in our hearts, and we will remember Ben & Eva Bean and the many hours we worked together on the many functions for Daviess RTL and the Support they gave us. We will always remember those dedicated members who worked so hard to start Daviess County Right To Life, especially the Wichman Family who are too nummerous to name here. We will always remember those early days and thank those who gave so much in the fight against Abortion. God Bless Them!

Daviess County Right to Life Discontinued Paper Drives but Will Still Have Aluminum Can Drives:



On Dec. 4, 2021 the Daviess County Right to Life held their last Paper Drive after more than 40 years of recycling newsprint. You can see here the picture of Mike Wichman as he closes the door of the semi-trailer for the last time. From 1978-2021, paper drives were a mainstay of Daviess County Right to Life's fundraising efforts, even becoming the main source of income for the organization at times.

Bernie Wichman, one of the original organizers behind the paper drive, was a cornerstone of the events, held the first Saturday of every even-numbered month, for 24 years. When his health failed and he passed away that same year, his son, Mike Wichman, stepped up to continue the work. Chuck and Steve Wichman, Mike's brothers, assisted faithfully as well for many years, following in the footsteps of Bernie Wichman and his brothers Bill and Bob.

Folks who helped with the paper drives remember Bernie Wichman's wife Alma bringing food for the workers, a tradition carried on by her daughter Mary Jo Sellers (Wichman). Mary Jo was faithfully involved with the Right to Life, holding the position of treasurer for the organization for many years. From their beginning in 1978 at the Washington Catholic School parking lot, paper drives were held in several Washington locations and other touch points around the county before coming to an end in 2021. Over the years, the amount of newspaper and aluminum cans has been exponential, often filling a semi in a single drive. Thousands of tons of paper have been spared from the landfill, in the process helping the cause of Daviess County Right to Life.

Donna Gentry leaves a long list of accomplishments, not only in the Right To Life and the Pregnancy Care Center, but also in other community organizations. Placing the Bench/Monument at the site where the Pregnancy Care Center was founded in January of 1999 was done by Daviess County Right To Life Organization to highlight the significance of that endeavor. This bench would also honor Donna Gentry who was the founder of the Pregnancy Care Center and honor the many lives she has been able to touch, the many people she has helped and for her many accomplishments in the pro-life movement. The work of the Pregnancy Care Center would not have been possible without the dedication of Donna Gentry to see it through.

Ever so often you come across an individual who has made such a huge impact on their community, and this has been evident in Donna Gentry's passing. The impact by Gentry was evident by the many people who paid their respects and to the large crowd who attended her Funeral. Donna's Granddaughter Brianne Rainey said it best as she ended her remarks at the Funeral. "We remember her as a great woman, but she wasn't, she was a simple woman that did great things through Jesus."

Donna's spirit will live on in the pro-life work she has started. We will never forget the contribution she has made to the unborn!

Winner of 2024 Donna Gentry Memorial Scholarship The Following Essay was written by Alexander Guinn

"What is happening to America because of abortion?"

It seems like every year, American popular culture becomes more like a culture of death. As time goes on, people become more and more desensitized to death than ever before. Some people would be quick to pin this issue solely on the media. The news, movies, television, social media, and even music has made murder and violent death a common and casual thought to most mainstream media consumers. Although the media is certainly not positive, I would pin the mass desensitization of Americans on something different: The "Pro-Choice" movement.

The Pro-Choice movement is truly a movement with a direct end of death. With some of their main causes being obtaining rights for abortion, euthanasia, and even infanticide, the movement reeks of death no matter how it's looked at. I think the issue begins with when pro-choicers consider life to be valuable. They may say it's when the child's heart beats, when they gain consciousness, or when they are not dependent on the mother's resources. These questions all expose a message the pro-choice community says without saying outright: the belief that not all life is valuable or equal in dignity.

The claim that a person must prove that their life holds value is an astronomical factor in America's ethical downfall. This idea is a slippery slope as well. The consensus of Americans used to mainly deem life as valuable after conception, then it became after a detectable heartbeat, then it was moved even further into the pregnancy. For now, infants need to be born to convince most people that their life has value, but just like boundaries have been pushed in the past, they could very well be pushed even further. This could eventually lead to a legalization of infanticide in our country.

Another core motive of the movement is selfishness. Pro-choice logic is inherently selfish, as it encourages the sacrifice of life for convenience. Pregnant women are encouraged to kill their children if they threaten to pose any inconvenience on the mother's life. Oftentimes institutions such as Planned Parenthood will use aborted children for their own selfish motives as well. They will sell the organs and body parts of babies to maximize the profit on their procedures. This outlook on the world encourages people to look at valuable lives as something to destroy purely for convenience or profit.

Another side of this issue is euthanasia. Euthanasia is another large instance where elderly lives are deemed unworthy of care and attention or said to no longer have value. The practice of euthanasia is a massive issue because, like abortion, it preaches convenience over virtue. Family members of the sick elderly may become convinced that their loved one is no longer worth caring for or keeping alive if they cannot be productive members of society. The idea of euthanasia brings another side of selfishness and disregard for life to American culture.

To conclude, issues like abortion, infanticide, and euthanasia are burdens on American society and have created a revolution of normalized and encouraged death in the name of profit and convenience. We say "Well Done Good and Faithful Servant". May the Angels welcome you into Paradise!




