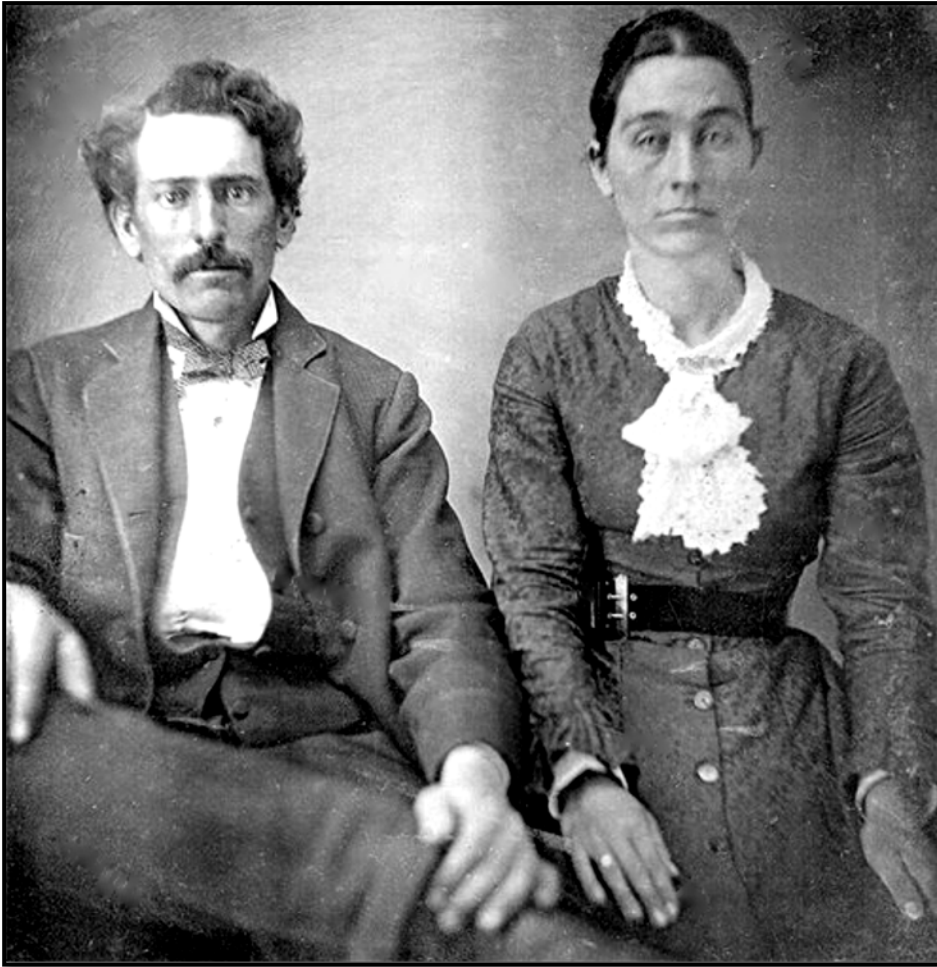


CHAPTER – 3D

JOHN AND MARY “HAGERTY” MCCAULEY



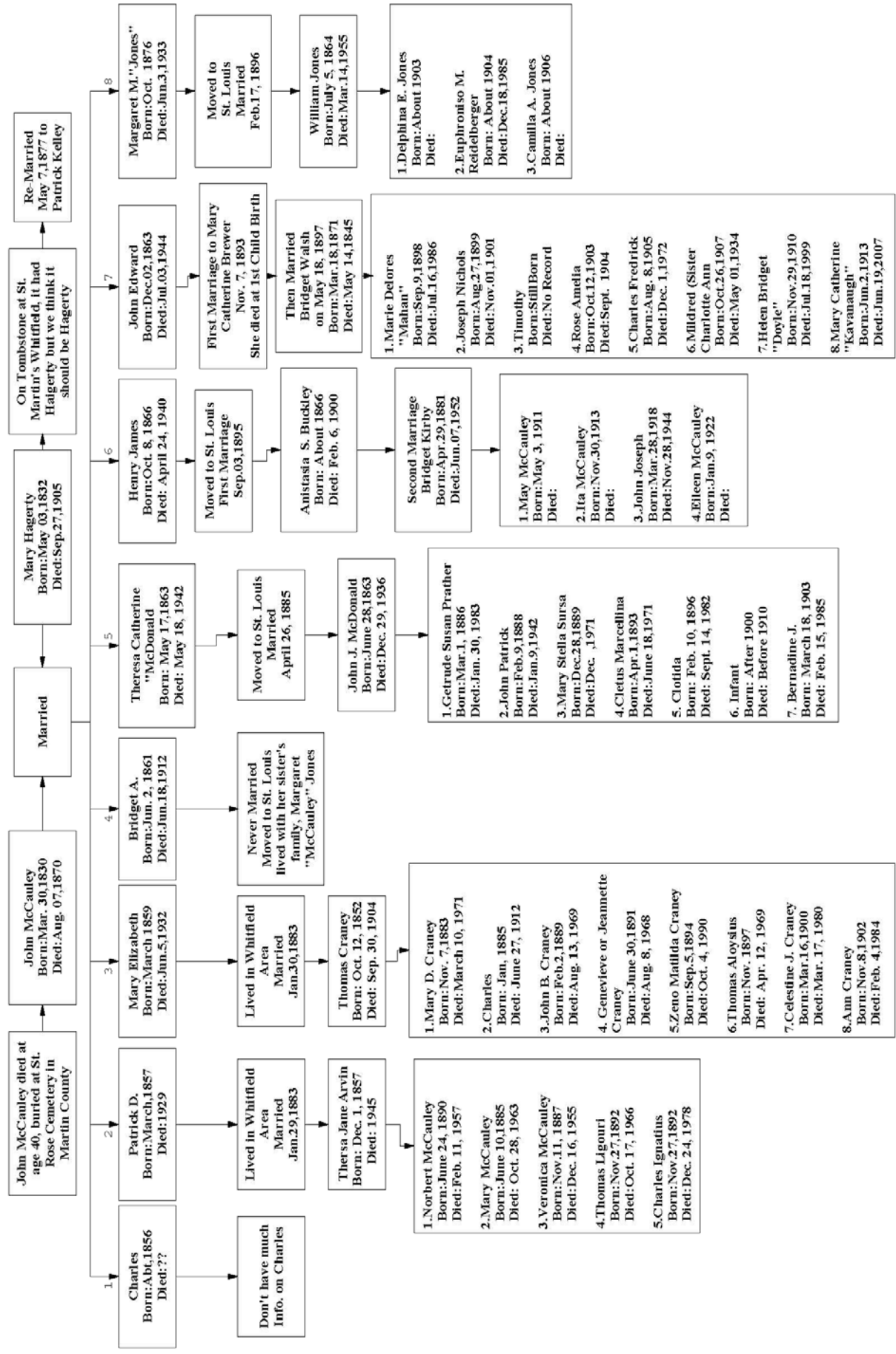
Left: Pictured are John and Mary “Hagerty” McCauley. John was born on Mary 3, 1830 and died on Aug. 7, 1870 in Martin County. John is buried in St. Rose Cemetery, Mt. Pleasant community, southeast of Loogootee. Mary Hagerty is buried in St. Martin’s Cemetery in Whitfield south of Loogootee with her maiden name on the tombstone. Mary was born on May 3 1832 and she died on Sept. 27 1905. John and Mary had eight children before John’s passing. Children born to this marriage was Charles, Patrick, Mary Elizabeth Craney, Bridget (Never Married), Theresa McDonald, Henry, John Edward, Margaret Jones. After John McCauley’s Death, Mary remarried Patrick Kelley on May 7, 1877 but she is not buried with her second husband.



Left: Tombstone of John McCauley, located in the old St. Rose Cemetery in the Mt. Pleasant Community. This community was abandoned after a plague hit the area killing many of the residents. It is not known if John McCauley was one of those victims. It is suspected that this is the reason why his wife was not buried in this cemetery. The story has been passed down that many buildings were burned down in order to try to prevent the disease from spreading. John’s father and mother are also buried in this cemetery. Written on the Tombstone is:

*John McCauley, Mar. 30, 1830,
Aug. 7, 1870. Mary His wife.*

Left: Mary McCauley (Wife of Charles McCauley) was born in 1810 in Ireland and died in 1871. She is buried at St. Rose's Cemetery at Mt. Pleasant Community. It reads, MARY Wife of Charles McCauley. Died Aug 21, 1878; AGE 69



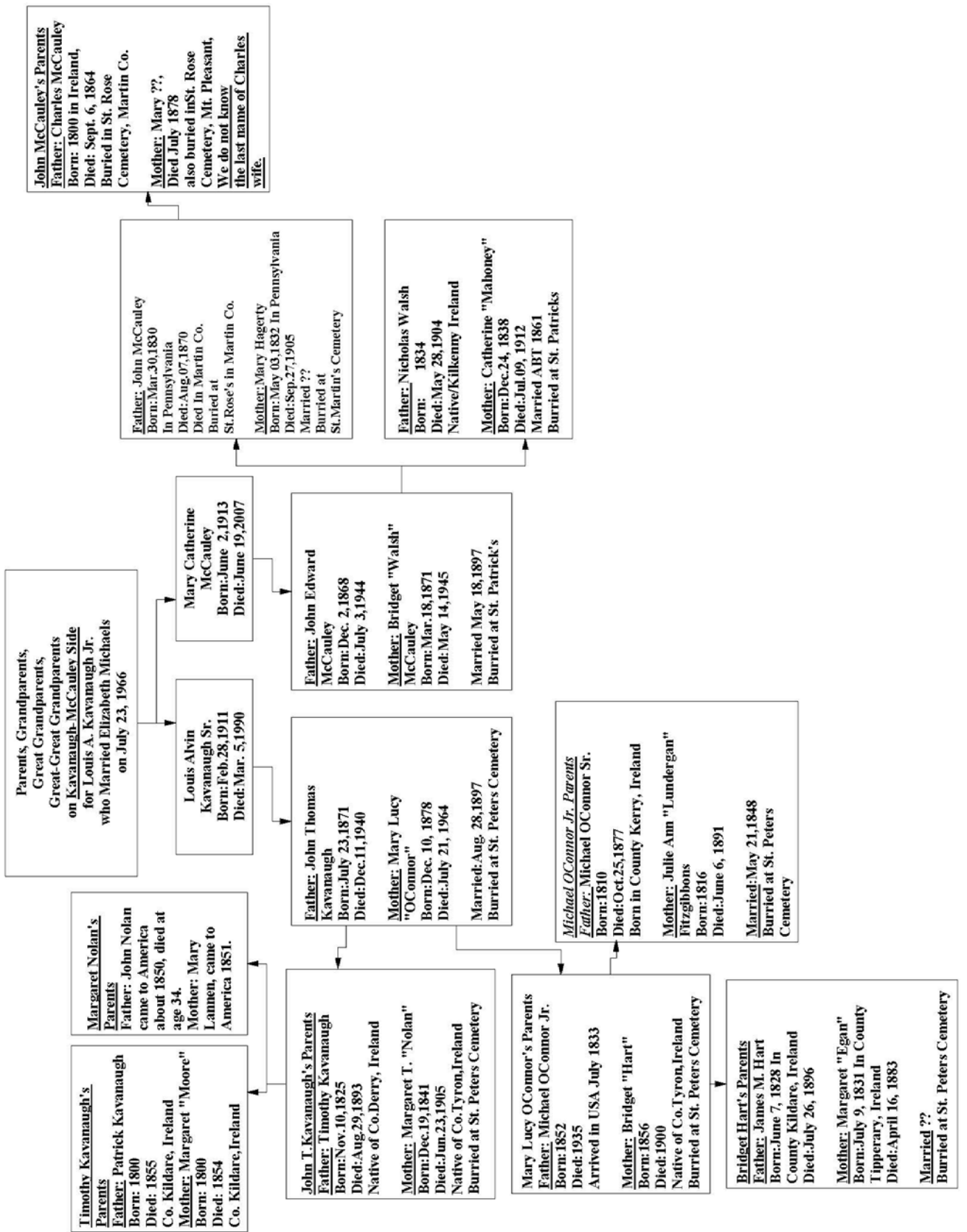
Left: Pictured here is the Tombstone for Charles McCauley as it lies on the ground partially covered by grass/dirt in St. Rose's Cemetery. Charles was married to Mary (not sure of her maiden name) and they lived in the Mt. Pleasant area. Charles and Mary's children were John, Elizabeth, Mary, Katherine, Henry, Matilda and Charles D. McCauley. There were three sons and four daughters.

Charles was born in Ireland in 1800 and died in 1864 at the age of 63.

Wording on the Tombstone: Charles, Husband of Mary McCauley, Died Sept. 6, 1864. Died 63 Years That would have put his date of birth around 1801. Charles McCauley was the father of John McCauley who had a son John Edward McCauley who had a daughter Catherine "McCauley" Kavanaugh who was my Mother.

Family Tree for Louis Kavanaugh Jr.

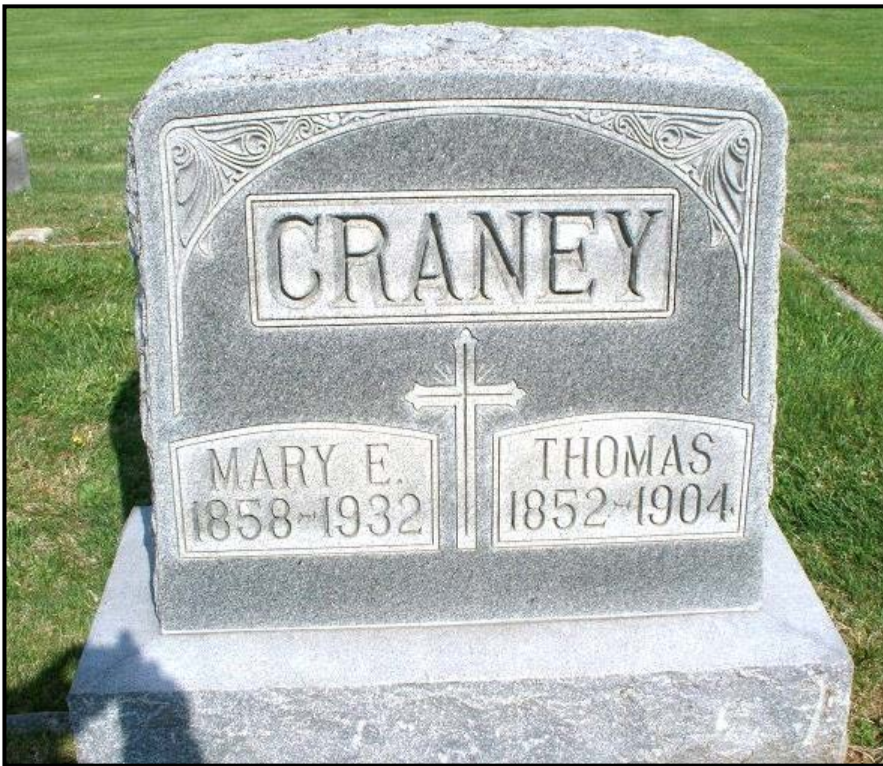

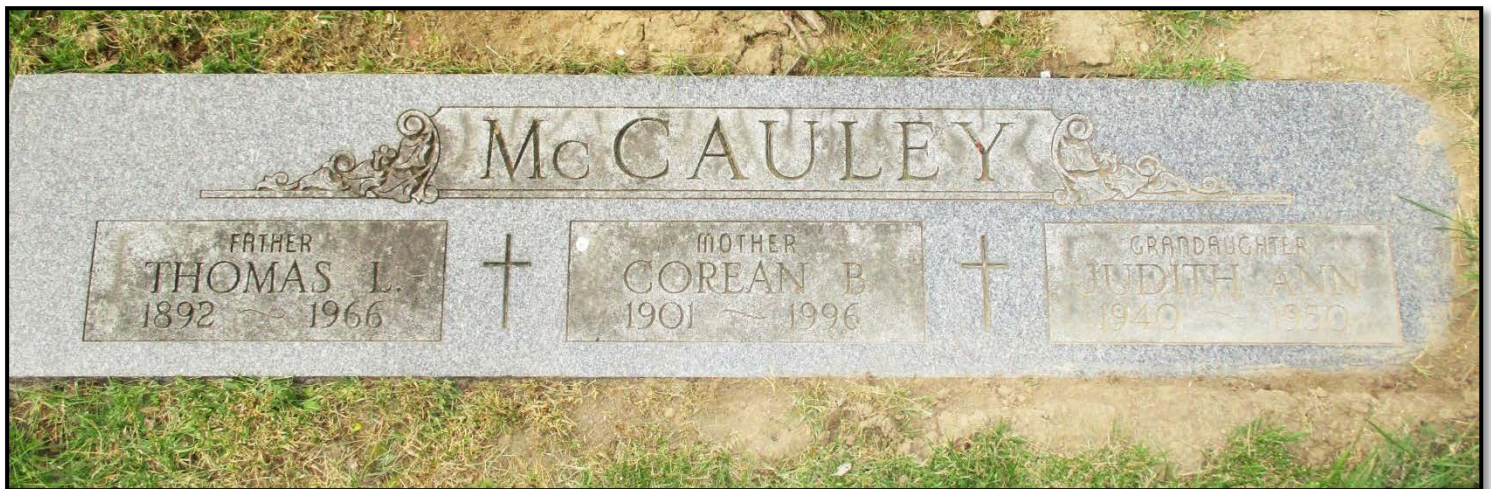
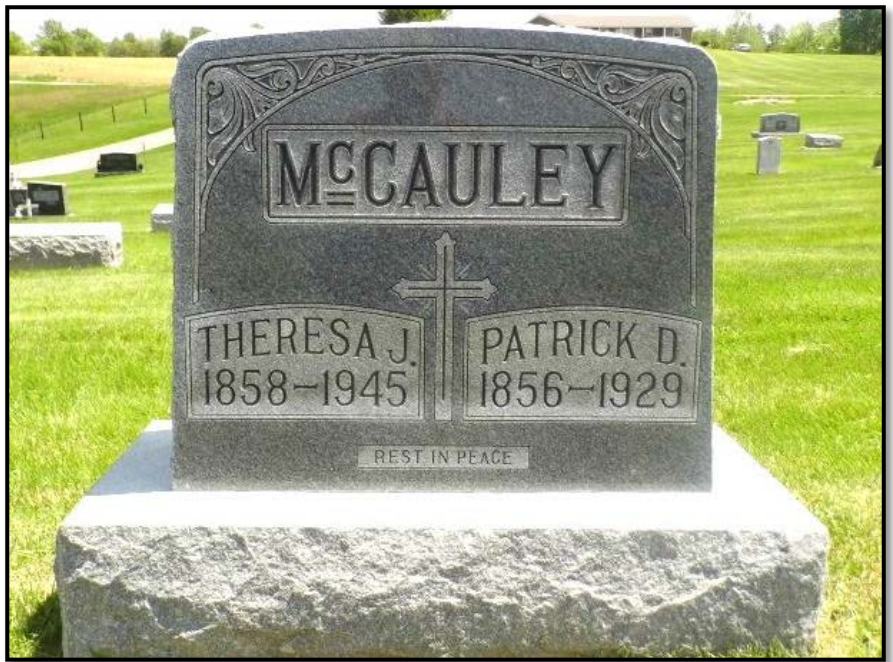

Left: the tombstone for Mary Liz “McCauley” Craney who was born in March of 1858 or 59, and died on June 5 of 1932. Her husband Thomas Craney was born in 1852 and died in 1904. Mary Liz was the daughter of John and Mary “Hagerty” McCauley. The Craney’s are buried in St. Martin’s Cemetery near Whitfield. Mary Liz and Thomas Craney had eight children, Mary D., Charles, John B., Genevieve, Zeno, Thomas A., Celestine and Ann. Mary Liz and Thomas Craney are buried in St. Martin’s Cemetery near Whitfield.

Right: the **tombstone of Patrick McCauley** who was born in 1856 and died in 1929. His wife Theresa “Arvin” McCauley was born in 1858 and died in 1945. Both are buried in St. Martin’s Cemetery near Whitfield. Patrick was the son of John and Mary “Hagerty” McCauley. They had five children, Norbert, Mary, Veronica, and twins Thomas Ligouri and Charles Ignatius. I believe that Thomas Ligouri married Corean “Walsh” McCauley.



Above: the **tombstone for Corean and Thomas Ligouri McCauley and their daughter Judith Ann.** Ligouri was born in 1892 and died in 1966. Corean was born in 1901 and died in 1996. Their daughter Judith was born in 1940 and died in 1950. Mom was a cousin to Corean on the Walsh side of the family and Ligouri was a cousin on the McCauley side of the family. We always referred to Corean as Aunt Corean as Mom said she was more of an Aunt to her than a cousin. Mom always spoke highly of Aunt Corean and was always included to family gathering even in her older years. I remember taking Mom and Dad to the funeral of Ligouri in the fall of 1966. Ligouri and Corean are buried in Holy Cross/St. Joseph Cemetery in south part of Indianapolis. Ligouri’s Parents were Patrick & Jane “Arvin” McCauley. Corean’s Parents were Edward P. Walsh & Ellen “Murphy” Nolan Walsh. Corean’s Mother was married to a Nolan and he passed away and she married Edward P. Walsh.



Left: is the tombstone of Veronica McCauley, daughter of Patrick and Theresa Jane Arvin McCauley. Veronica was born Nov. 11, 1887 and died Dec. 16, 1955. Veronica was a Sister to Norbert, Mary and twins Ligouri and Ignatius McCauley. Veronica is buried at St. Martin's Cemetery in Whitfield. Veronica would have been a first cousin to my mother Catherine Kavanaugh. Veronica's brother Ligouri was married to Corean Walsh McCauley. We called her Aunt Corean.

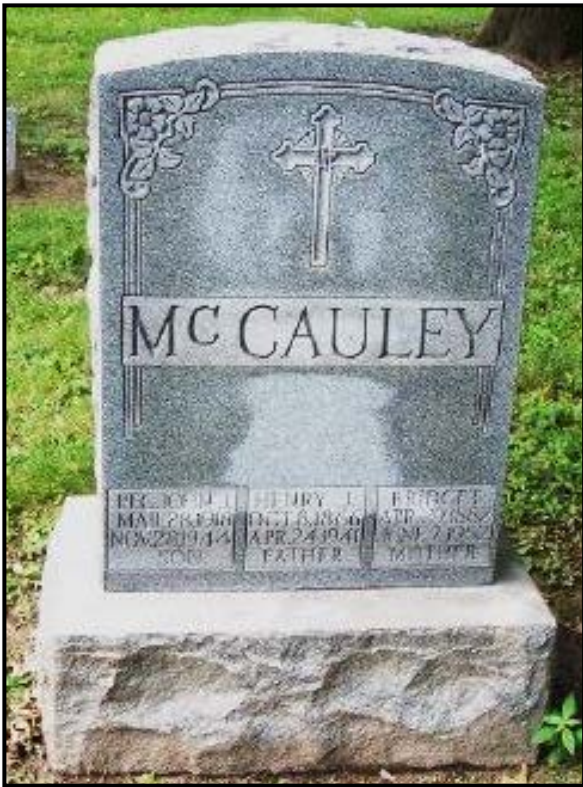

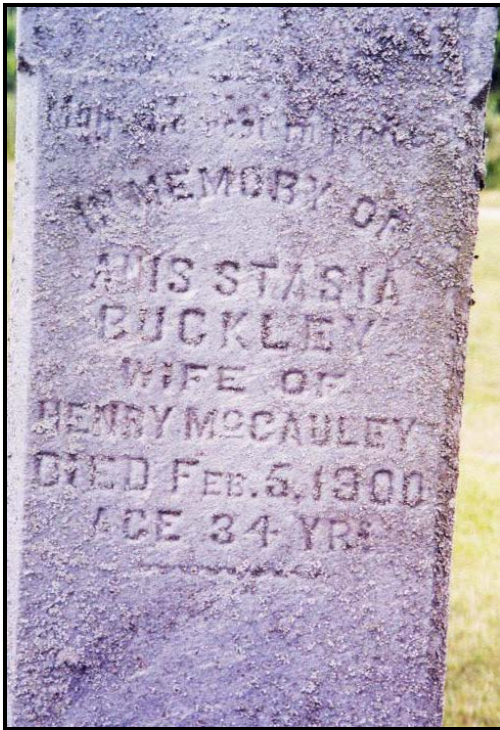

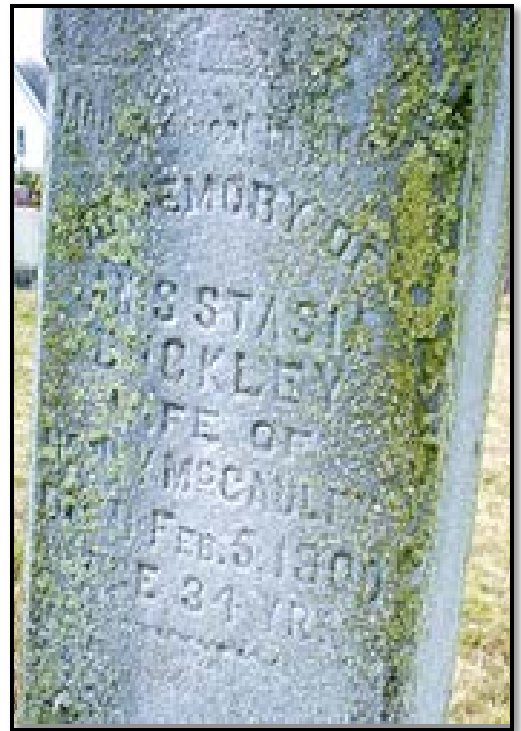

Left & Right: Shown here is the tombstone for Anastasia Buckley who was the first wife of Henry McCauley. She died at the age of 34. She was born about 1866 and died on Feb. 5, 1900. Henry and Anastasia had no children. Henry remarried Bridget Kirby and moved to St. Louis, Mo. and they had 4 children. Henry was a brother to John E. McCauley which was my Grandfather. Anastasia Buckley is buried in St. Patrick's Cemetery in Corning.

Bridget was born June 2, 1861 and died June 18, 1912. Bridget lived in St. Louis with relatives and died of cancer but was brought back and buried at St. Martin’s Cemetery in Whitfield. She was never married. She was a sister to my Grand Father John E. McCauley.

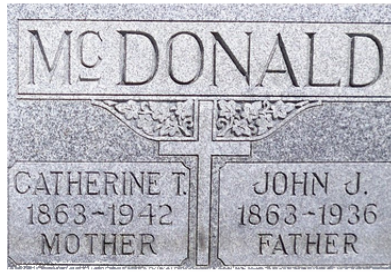

Pictured left is the info. found for Catherine Teresa "McCauley" who married John McDonald and lived in the St. Louis area. Teresa was born on May 17, 1863 and died on May 18, 1942 and John McDonald was born on June 28, 1863 and died on Dec. 29, 1936. They are buried in Mt. Carmel Cemetery Belleville, Ill. They had 7 children: Gertrude, John, Mary, Cletus, Clotida, Bernadine and an infant who died at birth. Teresa "McCauley" McDonald was a sister to my Grandfather John E. McCauley.



Above is the tombstone of Euphronius and her husband Edgar Reidelberger. Euphronius was a daughter of William & Margaret Jones and they are buried in the same cemetery plot as her parents in Calvary Cemetery in St. Louis MO. Edgar was born in 1905 and died in 1970 and Euphronius was born in 1903 and died in 1985.

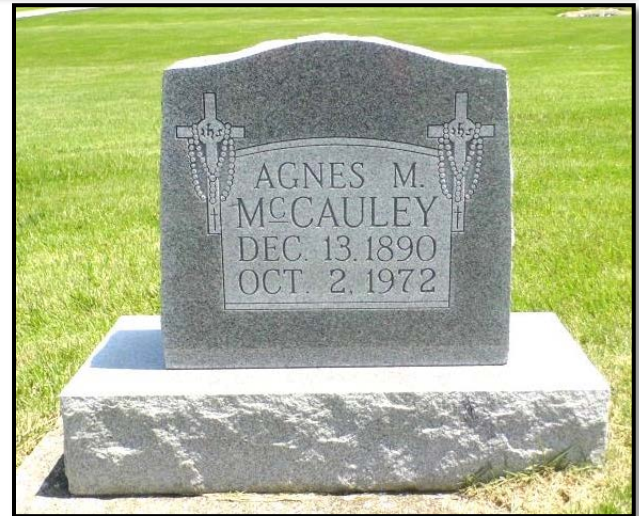

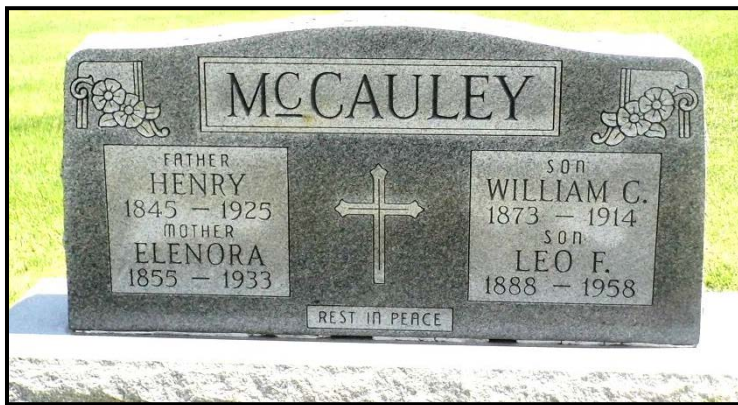

Above is the tombstone for William Jones who was the husband of Margaret "McCauley". They moved to St. Louis and are buried in Calvary Cemetery. William was born July 5, 1864 and died on Mar. 14, 1955 at the age of 90. Margaret his wife was born on Oct. 1876 and died on June 3, 1933. They had three Children, Delphina, Euphronius and Camilla. Their daughter Euphronius and her Husband Edgar Reidelberger are buried in the same plot there in the cemetery. Margaret "McCauley" Jones was a sister to my Grandfather John E. McCauley.



Above: the tombstone for Agnes M. McCauley who was the daughter of Henry and Elenora "Patterson" McCauley. Agnes was born Dec. 13, 1890 and died Oct. 2, 1972. She is buried in St. Martin's Cemetery in Whitfield. Agnes's dad Henry and John E. McCauley's Dad (John Sr.) were brothers so Agnes was a 1st cousin to John E. my Grandfather.



Above the tombstone for Henry McCauley (1845-1925) and his wife Elenora "Patterson" (1855-1933) and their two sons William (1873-1914) and Leo (1888-1958). Henry was an Uncle to John E. McCauley, My Grandfather. Henry and my Great Grandfather were brothers. Henry and his wife Elenora are buried at St. Martin's Cemetery in Whitfield. Their two sons are buried there as well.
