
Pat & Julie (O'Connor) Kavanaugh Family

P. W. KAVANAUGH TAKEN BY DEATH

Patricks W. Kavanaugh, age 81, retired farmer, died at 7:40 o'-clock Saturday night at his home in Cannelburg after a three years' illness. His condition took a turn for the worse three weeks ago.

Mr. Kavanaugh was a son of Timothy and Margaret Nolen Kavanaugh and he was born in Daviess county March 17, 1868. He married Julia O'Connor on Sept. 10, 1907, and she survives with these children: James and Robert Kavanaugh, of Cannelburg, Mrs. Margaret Grow of Cannelburg, and Paul Kavanaugh and Mrs. Mary Kleeman, of Jasper. There are also 14 grandchildren and a sister, Miss Margaret Kavanaugh, of Cannelburg. Two children are dead.

He was a member of All Saint's Catholic church at Cannelburg and funeral services will be held there at 9 a. m., Tuesday morning with burial in St. Peter's cemetery. Rosary services will be held at the Miller funeral home in Loogoetee at 7 o'clock tonight.


