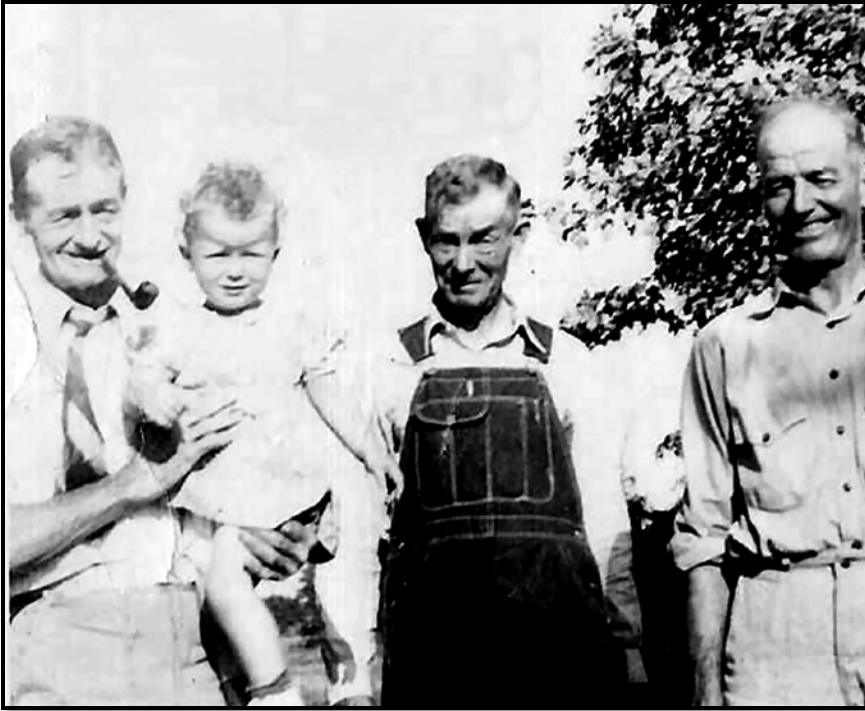


## CHAPTER – 5G
