
CHAPTER-7

It is the second oldest Catholic Church in Indiana. It was established in 1818 and the Church celebrated its 200th Anniversary in June of 2018. When you approach the town of Montgomery on Highway 50 from the west or the east you can see the Golden Dome just like the one at Nota Dame. In fact, this historic church was to be the site of the University, but the Bishop back then decided not to let them build a University and the Holy Cross Brothers picked up and left in the early 1800s and moved to South Bend, where they established the University there. 


Inside St. Peter's Church as it looks today. There are many descendants of the Michaels

The Main Altars for St. Peter's Church as it appears now.


