Banquet Speaker Terry Beatley, Author of “What If We’ve Been Wrong”



Terry Beatley is the author of *What If We’ve Been Wrong?* This book is a story about Dr. Bernard Nathanson (co-founder of NARAL) and how he helped to deceive the American public and the American press into accepting Abortion here in America. In Dr. Nathanson’s last days when he was dying, he opened up his soul to Terry and told her the whole story and wanted her to get the message out to the American people on how they had been deceived on abortion issue.

Keeping her promise to Dr. Nathanson and in a rare interview in 2009, Terry Beatley accepted the pro-life challenge of Dr. Bernard Nathanson. Terry promised to expose his 8-point strategy of deception that led to the decriminalization of abortion and exploitation of women and their children. In addition, she promised to deliver Dr. Nathanson’s personal parting message to America in the hope that it would help to overturn *Roe vs. Wade*, the decision that legalized abortion.

Terry founded Hosea Initiative, a non-profit organization which teaches the impact of the pro-life conversion story of Dr. Nathanson. It also explains the cultural context of the abortion industry’s propaganda. Terry’s book, “What If We’ve Been Wrong?”, was released in September 2016. In 2017, Hosea Initiative released a “Becoming a Witness for Life,” a Catholic High School Unit Study on the life of Dr. Bernard Nathanson which parallels the book. Terry has the exclusive movie rights to all of Dr. Nathanson’s writings with plans for a feature film.

Terry is a 2015 worldview graduate of Chuck Colson’s Fellows Program, former Virginia coordinator for ParentalRights.org, a former investment broker of 14 years and a retired homeschool mother of two daughters. In 1986, Terry graduated from Virginia Tech with a B.S. in Business. She currently serves on the Virginia Christian Alliance Board of Directors and she is on the executive team for Deborah’s Voice 2018. Terry has been married for 31 years to Kenny Beatley and they have two grown children. Terry was baptized Catholic as a child and in the process of writing her book, returned to the Catholic Church. They are members of St. Francis de Sales Church in Lancaster, Virginia.

The following account is how the adoption came to pass in the words of Christy Farhar.

The Adoption Story

In 2013 our youngest son, Cole was a senior in high school. Aimee was in college and Chad was already out on his own. In the fall of 2012 Ed had mentioned that we would have a lot of empty space once Cole graduated and that he had some plans for it. I was a little naive in thinking that meant a remodel to include an office. When Ed approached the subject of foster care, was reluctant due to having parents that were foster parents and seeing how hard that journey can be but after much thought realized how it was needed and so we began the certification process.

In March of 2013 I was in surgery for carpal tunnel when Ed got the call for a placement of three kids needing a home for a temporary time and so that evening we waiting a little impatiently for their arrival. When they came there were actually four children. Jadaya was 6, Daniel 4, Ryken 3 and Millie 2. Talk about an adjustment! It had been a long time since we had small children but it was a fun adventure. It became apparent that the children may be with us for longer than we first anticipated. We wanted to be a resource to the biological parents and help them in any way we could. We went into foster care for just that. We had no plans for adoption but God's plans are better than our own!

In October of that year the children went to a trial home visit that ended sooner than it was supposed to and that really made us think of the longevity that this may be taking. We continued on the foster care journey with visits and team meetings and paperwork not knowing what was in store for us. In early 2014 our case manager came to us and asked if we were interested in adoption and we had to make a decision then as to what we would do if it came to that.

Knowing that the possibility of the sibling group would be split up and how much we had grown to love the kids we took the

proper classes to be approved to adopt. Foster care is a long process and while many get frustrated in it, we know that there are steps that have to be taken to give every opportunity to the biological parents.

While adoption is a beautiful thing, it can also be a tragic thing for children. Kids need their parents and so we are thankful that there is a process in place to ensure they have exhausted every avenue possible. We adopted the children April 22, 2015 and they have brought so much joy to our lives. Many people ask us why we chose to walk this path and to that we often say sometimes we allow our heart to overtake our brains. There are still struggles but we know that God will make this story a beautiful one if we allow Him to do so.

HISTORY OF DAVIESS COUNTY RIGHT TO LIFE INC.

The Daviess County Right To Life Organization was founded in November of 1976 when a small group of people met and decided it was time to form an organization in Daviess County to promote life and work to overturn the Roe vs. Wade Decision which legalized abortion in 1973. A group from Evansville was instrumental in helping our organization get started. Some of the individuals from Daviess County helping to form the organization was Bob Johnson Pastor of Plainville Christian Church along with Ben Ray & Eva Bean, Pastor of Bethany Christian Church, along with Bernie & Alma Wichman, Bill & Josephine Wichman, Margaret Wichman and Vic Hopkins. Bob Johnson became the first president of the organization.

Daviess County Right To Life held its first Banquet in November of 1977 with Wayne Smith as the Speaker, and it was held at the Plainville Lions Club Building in Plainville. We have held a banquet each year since that time, and this has become the highlight of the year for the organization as hundreds of pro-life people come together to renew their effort in the fight against abortion in this country. After the first Banquet was held in Plainville the Banquet was then held at Washington High School for two years and then moved to the Ruritan Building in Montgomery for the next 26 of 27 years with the exception of the Gasthof Restaurant in 1997 before moving to the Simon J. Graber Building which will be the third year. Each time it was moved to accommodate the larger crowds that attend the Banquets.

In 1980 Daviess County RTL was put on the Map when our Banquet was held at the Montgomery Ruritan Building as Dr. Jack Willke and Barb Willke spoke to the nearly 500 who attended this event. The Pro-Life Movement was just coming on the National scene, and National CBS sent a film crew from Chicago to cover this event. The State Right To Life President attended along with Dan Quayle who was running against Senator Birch Bayh made a guest appearance. Film clips from this event were seen on National TV on the CBS Morning Show a day later. The reason the film crew came was to find out why the grass roots pro-life movement was growing so fast and to gage the impact it might have on the 1980 elections, and it did not take long to find out. The film crew could not

get over the large crowd that attended in this rural area and was impressed with Southern Indiana Hospitality. Future Banquet Speakers have included major names in the pro-life movement and national figures.

Daviess County Right To Life Organization has been instrumental in helping other Right To Life Groups in our area to form or to give them a helping hand either with donations or with organizational help for their organization. Daviess County Right To Life has been very much involved on the State Level as our local President has not only served as State President but has served on the National Right To Life Board of Directors representing Indiana. Daviess Co. RTL has not only been active in our local area but have been active on the State and Federal level as well. Daviess County Right To Life Organization does not receive funding grants or donations from State or Federal organizations of any kind. The only sources of income for the Organization is from donations from its members and Paper Drives which was started back in 1978 and continues to this day. Daviess Co. RTL opened an office on Main Street in Washington in the early part of 1998, and thru the efforts of then President Donna Gentry opened the Pregnancy Care Center in January of 1999. The Center has now grown where it has its own identity and office staff and serves hundreds of individuals each year. The Pregnancy Care Center and Daviess County Right To Life Organization now share offices in the lower level of the Grace Baptist Church on Troy Road in Washington.

In the 33 years of existence Daviess County Right To Life has only had three Presidents, Bob Johnson from 1976 to 1978, Louis Kavanaugh Jr. from 1978-1995, Donna Gentry from 1995 to 2006 and Louie Kavanaugh Jr. has returned to the office of President in January of 2007 to the present time. Daviess County Right to Life has been very blessed with so many dedicated people who have given so much of their time and effort for the organization. Daviess County RTL has promoted life and worked against abortion thru Radio and Newspaper ads, Booths at Fairs and Montgomery Turkey Trot, put on programs at churches and schools and have lobbied our elected officials to support pro-life legislation. Although we are small in numbers, we have individuals who give it their all for the organization.

Our Organization was hit hard in January of 2011 while honoring Donna Gentry with a Memorial Bench at the site of the First Pregnancy Care Center She suddenly took ill and died a few days later. It was a shock to the organization and to her family and friends who knew her well. She

was the founder of the Pregnancy Care Center and served as President of the Daviess Co. RTL for 1995-2006 and worked tirelessly for the organization. Many projects she undertook was a real shot in the arm not only to the organization but to the pro-life movement. She ran for State Representative on two occasions and nearly upset a long term incumbent in her first try for public office.

Although we have made history in the past, we truly hope the history we make in the future will be that all lives of the unborn are protected from conception to natural death. May God Bless our all of us in our work and Bless our Country!

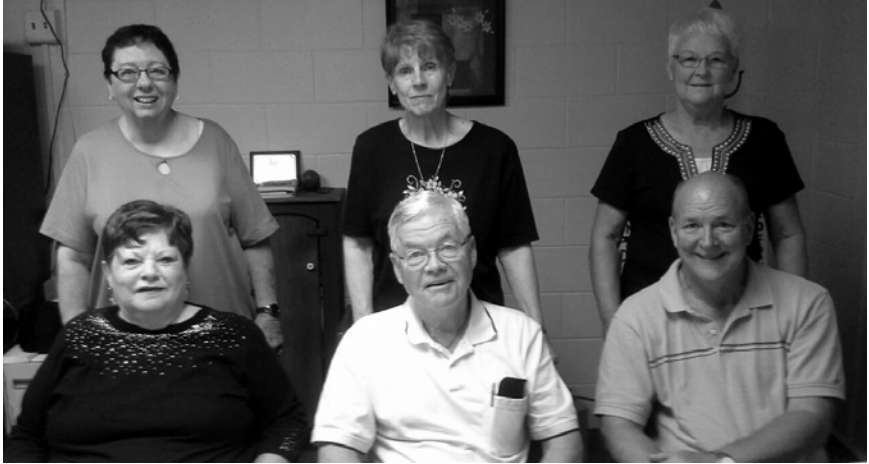

Bethany Christian Church, Near Montgomery, Site Where Daviess Co. RTL Held Meeting for Many Years



The picture above of the old Bethany Christian Church west of Montgomery on Hwy 50 was taken just two days before the church was taken down. This was the site where Daviess County Right To Life held its meetings for many years. After the first meeting was held at the YMCA in Washington the meetings were moved to Bethany Church in 1976. Ben Bean who was the Pastor there for over 40 years invited the Right To Life to hold their meetings at the church and Ben Bean became the Vice President and held that position for many years. Ben & Eva Bean were very hospitable to the Right to Life members, and many lasting friendships were made because of Ben's invitation to the Right To Life.

When Donna Gentry took over as President, and the Pregnancy Care Center was started in January of 1999, the meetings were then moved to the Main Street location of the PCC on Main Street in Washington. After the building sold, the Right To Life & the PCC were moved to 608 West Walnut Street in September of 2004. In November of 2008 the Right To Life and the PCC moved to the present location on 705 Troy Road in the lower level of the Grace Baptist Church. They are very pleased with the location and the facilities.

It was sad to see the church taken down, but the membership of the church had grown so much they built a new church on highway 57 south of Washington. The old church was taken down on Monday August 11, and it took several days for the clean up. The old site of Bethany Christian Church will always have a soft spot in our hearts, and we will remember Ben & Eva Bean and the many hours we worked together on the many functions for Daviess RTL and the Support they gave us. We will always remember those dedicated members who worked so hard to start Daviess County Right To Life, especially the Wichman Family who are too numerous to name here. We will always remember those early days and thank those who gave so much in the fight against Abortion. God Bless Them!

Paper Drives Continue for Right to Life Organization

Mike Wichman who is now in charge of the Right To Life Paper Drives took over after his Dad Bernie Wichman got sick in 2002 and passed away. Bernie Wichman took care of the Paper Drives from the beginning back in 1978 until his health failed, and Mike, his son, took up the torch. Mike has always helped at the drives and along with his brothers Chuck and Steve Wichman were always dependable help for the drives. In fact, the the Wichman Family has always been well represented at the Paper Drives. Beginning with Bernie and his brothers Bill and Bob and Bernie's children and other members of the Wichman Family, we could not have done it without them. Bernie’s wife Alma always made the sandwiches and got the soft drinks for the crew. When Alma got sick and was unable to do it anymore, their daughter Mary Jo “Wichman” Sellers took over and does it to this day. Mary Jo was also the Treasurer for the Daviess Co. Right To Life for many years and has continued the tradition of the Wichman family helping out at these paper drives. Many of the Wichman Grandchildren have helped at one time or another and continue to do so to this day.

The Paper Drives started back in 1978 at the parking lot next to Washington Catholic School, then moved to old 3-D Plaza, then to the old Big Blue Parking lot and then to Old K-Mart Parking lot, to the Fastenal lot and now back to the Tractor Supply Parking Lot (Old K-Mart Lot.) Over the years the Paper Drives would fill a full semi in one day, but now because of the cut back in newsprint it may take two drives or more to fill a semi-trailer. In the last several years the Right To Life has started recycling aluminum cans, and this has proved to be very beneficial to the group. At one time the Paper Drives also took magazines, but we do not have an outlet to sell them and that was discontinued years ago.

The Paper Drives are held the first Sat. of the even months of the year with the main location at the Tractor Supply Parking lot in Washington. We have pickup points at Plainville, Odon, Elnora, and Montgomery. Over the years it is estimated we have saved a thousand or more tons of paper from going to the landfill and in the process helped the local RTL Organization to promote life. At one point the Paper Drives were the main source of income for the organization but now our donations have increased and have helped the organization to do even more in the battle against abortion. We thank everyone for their support of these drives and hope you will continue to recycle.

In Memory of Donna Gentry

November 16, 1941 - February 2, 2011

Donna suffered a massive stroke towards the end of the ceremony and was taken to the hospital and passed away five days later on Wednesday afternoon, February 2. She was laid to rest on Saturday, February 5.

Donna Gentry leaves a long list of accomplishments, not only in the Right To Life and the Pregnancy Care Center, but also in other community organizations. Placing the Bench/Monument at the site where the Pregnancy Care Center was founded in January of 1999 was done by Daviess County Right To Life Organization to highlight the significance of that endeavor. This bench would also honor Donna Gentry who was the founder of the Pregnancy Care Center and honor the many lives she has been able to touch, the many people she has helped and for her many accomplishments in the pro-life movement. The work of the Pregnancy Care Center would not have been possible without the dedication of Donna Gentry to see it through.

Ever so often you come across an individual who has made such a huge impact on their community, and this has been evident in Donna Gentry's passing. The impact by Gentry was evident by the many people who paid their respects and to the large crowd who attended her Funeral. Donna's Granddaughter Brianne Rainey said it best as she ended her remarks at the Funeral. **"We remember her as a great woman, but she wasn't, she was a simple woman that did great things through Jesus."**

Donna's spirit will live on in the pro-life work she has started.

We will never forget the contribution she has made to the unborn!

"What is happening to America because of abortion?"

Abortion in America is a huge problem. As citizens it is time to talk about the number one right every person pre or post natal. The right to life. America is being impacted by the astronomical number of abortion procedures, the insane adoption waiting time, and the ever growing acceptance to the abortion procedure.

In 2014, 652,639 legal abortions were reported in America. Of those, 8,180 abortions were conducted in Indiana. We need to let the fact that our very own state has killed over eight thousand children sink in. Eight thousand one hundred and eighty lost opportunities. Eight thousand one hundred and eighty potential warriors for Christ were denied the right to live in our state alone while thousands of families are waiting with open arms to adopt them into their homes.

The average adoption wait time is two to seven years across the nation. According to the website, Pregnant Pause, if abortions were made illegal and every one of those children was given to adoption it would take nearly four years to satisfy every American family wanting to adopt. That is not counting the new families that would want to adopt during that time. If all 652,639 children were available for adoption tomorrow those who dropped off the adoption waiting list in discouragement would apply again. If abortions were illegal over half a million children could be living in happy, healthy homes.

The last point we will discuss today, and possibly the most devastating, is the ever growing acceptance of abortion. In 2014 an abortion study was conducted. Surveyed were women who had gone through the procedure. Sixty percent of the women were in their 20s. Three out of four women surveyed were economically disadvantaged. Through the years Planned Parenthood and Pro Choice organizations have become increasingly brave in the march against our Right to Life movement. Planned Parenthood is targeting the economically disadvantaged by offering free condoms, free STD testing, and free pregnancy testing. They also advertise in low income areas. To advocate for abortion they use slogans such as "every child is a loved child" and "you know what is best for the life of this child." By saying these things they help to justify the abortion in the minds of these vulnerable women.

In conclusion, abortion is directly impacting America in a variety of ways. Three major explanations of the impact are the astronomical number of abortion procedures, the insane adoption waiting time, and the ever growing acceptance to the idea of abortion itself. With all of these factors piled against the Right to Life movement one could wonder if all hope is lost. Thankfully, we have an organization such as the Pregnancy Care Center. I have been volunteering at the center for over 150 hours. At the center we offer women the resources they need to follow through with their pregnancy. We offer a program called earn while you learn. In this program parents-to-be watch short videos to learn about the trials of pre and postnatal life. They earn vouchers that are redeemable in the form of car seats, cribs, mattresses, and other large expenses. By offering this program we are helping to eliminate the economical factor of abortion. One step at a time volunteers like myself are helping end the killing spree that America calls abortion.
