Banquet Speaker Father Frank Pavone, Exec. Director of Priests for Life



Daviess/Pike and Martin County Right to Life Groups are happy to announce that Father Frank Pavone will be the Banquet Speaker at their Annual Banquet on Oct. 6 of this year.

Father FRANK PAVONE is one of the most prominent pro-life leaders in the world. Originally from New York, he was ordained in 1988 by Cardinal John O'Connor, and has dedicated his entire life and ministry to ending abortion.

In 1993 he requested and received permission to serves as the National Director of Priests for Life, the largest pro-life ministry in the Catholic Church. He is also the President of the National Pro-life Religious Council, and the National Pastoral Director of the Silent No More Awareness Campaign and of Rachel's Vineyard, the world's largest ministry of healing after abortion.

Father Pavone travels throughout the country, to an average of four states every week, preaching and teaching against abortion. He broadcasts daily to hundreds of thousands of people on television, radio and online programs.

We are grateful to have Father Pavone as our speaker for this evening and we welcome him to our community.

The Adoption Story

Jacob and I got married on April 3, 2010 after two and a half years of dating. We both had discussed and agreed we wanted a large family and it didn't take long for that dream to seemingly get crushed by four letters from my doctor... PCOS. We were told the chances I could have a child was slim. In June of 2012, we decided that we would continue to try until January 2013 before we started looking into adoption organizations. Little did we know, God had a plan in motion as we laid out our own plans. I received a phone call from Joe Knepp asking us if we would take a little boy for 7 weeks until his mother was released from prison through what we know as 'Prison Baby Ministries.' I was ecstatic!!!! Yes, it was only 7 weeks but I was going to get to love on a little bundle of joy. Little did I know that on that same day, Jake gets a phone call from a friend asking us if we would be open to adoption! He said he had received a phone call from a family member and he and his wife sat down to pray about it and Jake's face was the first to pop into his mind so he picked up the phone and made the call. We hadn't discussed our fertility issues with many so this was a God thing. Jake took me out on a date that evening and later dropped the bombshell! TWINS!!!! He said he had already told him yes because he didn't even need to ask me. We met with the parents a few evenings later and that started a journey on a rollercoaster... a very hilly one!

At some point during the pregnancy, my mom and I both had separate dreams that the twins would make their appearance on December 17. On December 16, Jake and I attended church with my parents and before we left, my mom looked at me and said, 'tomorrow is the 17th... don't give up on that!'. At this point, the birth mom hadn't given me any reason to even think she would deliver earlier than her scheduled delivery date of January 9th.

Monday, December 17, 2012... Jake and I woke up and were off to work. Around noon, I had a missed call from the birth mom and my heart did a small flip flop. I called her back and she informed me the twins were here and we were welcome to head to the hospital to meet them. I didn't know who to call first!! Mom to tell her she was right or Jake. I called Jake (of course) and told him I was heading up to pick him up... then I called the rest of our families. As I drove out of the Graber Post parking lot and turned north, I drove through a bright, from one side of the road to the other, rainbow. Chills went down my spine as I had this peace rush over me and a voice saying, "this I have promised you." No one else saw that rainbow that day!! Blakeley Carter was born

at 4:21am and weighed 5lbs 8oz. Jakobi Titus was born at 4:23am and weighed 5lbs 10oz.

The twins birth parents signed over their rights on December 19 and we became the guardians of two small healthy babies. Blakeley had a feeding tube to help her eat so we didn't get released until December 21.

In August 2013 we received a surprise that we never dreamed we would be given. A positive pregnancy test. With twins only 8 months old, we had to laugh and wonder how we would handle 3 under 2 but knew that no matter what, we were not alone in this journey. November 27, 2013 our hearts broke when our doctor informed us our baby no longer had a heartbeat. "Why" was the only word and question I had... why 'tease' us with a something I was told I couldn't have? Why take this baby from us before we had a chance to meet it? I delivered a tiny baby boy on November 29, 2013 at 10pm.

Fast forward to the spring of 2017. Baby Dalton's mom reached out to me asking if we would adopt her baby due in January of 2018. Of course I couldn't say no and since I already had a relationship with her, what could go wrong?! We picked out the name Wrenley Rhys for this sweet baby girl and anxiously prepared for her arrival. We had a family trip scheduled for spring break 2018 but decided to move it to Christmas break so we weren't traveling with a fairly new baby over spring break. On our way home, she called to let me know she decided to keep the baby. All of the same questions came flooding back... WHY????!!!! Looking back, there was something different about this experience. There wasn't as much peace, there wasn't the preparedness... I think deep down God had prepared me for a heart break. I don't know how to explain it other than that... I somehow knew deep down it wasn't right.

April 8, 2018... this same mom sent me a Facebook message asking if we were still interested in adopting. Her friend was 7 months pregnant and was looking for someone to take it. Of course I couldn't say no even when I knew that the potential of being heartbroken once again was real. I spoke to Jamie the next morning and she knew what she wanted. She wanted us to take her baby boy as long as we would visit and not push her out of his life. We hired a lawyer and off we were on another journey.

I visited Jamie on several occasions, going with her to her doctor's appointments, and helping to decide the delivery date. During this time, once again, God surprised us again with another positive pregnancy test.

The delivery date was set for July 18, 2018. The hospital gave Jake and the twins a room across the hall and I sat with Jamie during labor. Makaiah Bennett was born at 1:34pm and weighed 8lbs 7oz. Jamie allowed me to be a part of each detail that day. I was able to cut the cord, hold him for the first skin-to-skin, and Makaiah was in our room the whole time. Papers were signed on July 19th and we were released on July 20th. Because he was not born in Indiana, we had to stay in Michigan until Michigan released him and Indiana accepted him. We stayed in a hotel just a few miles from the line and spent this time as a family

adjusting to a newborn. On July 27th, we were released to head back to Indiana, we checked out of the hotel and to our surprise, someone had paid for our entire hotel bill. Jake and I, along with the hotel clerk, cried as we tried to fully comprehend what someone had done for us.

Due to being diagnosed with preeclampsia at 30 weeks, I gave birth to Ezekiel 'Zeke' David on December 1, 2018 at 33w6d. He weighed 3lbs and was 16in long but a fighter!

Jake and I stayed in contact with Jamie and each summer spent a day with her on the beach over Makaiah's birthday. Unfortunately on June 18, 2022, Jamie lost her life. We ask that each of you keep her dad Mike and two siblings in your prayers.

Lord willing, Jake and I will be adding baby number 5 to our family in early January 2023.

God had every detail, big and small, written out for our lives. Jake and I couldn't have laid it out more perfectly if we had tried. Our story is a God story and we are thankful and excited to be a part of this journey.

HISTORY OF DAVIESS COUNTY RIGHT TO LIFE INC.

The Daviess County Right To Life Organization was founded in November of 1976 when a small group of people met and decided it was time to form an organization in Daviess County to promote life and work to overturn the Roe vs. Wade Decision which legalized abortion in 1973. A group from Evansville was instrumental in helping our organization get started. Some of the individuals from Daviess County helping to form the organization was Bob Johnson Pastor of Plainville Christian Church along with Ben Ray & Eva Bean, Pastor of Bethany Christian Church, along with Bernie & Alma Wichman, Bill & Josephine Wichman, Margaret Wichman and Vic Hopkins. Bob Johnson became the first president of the organization.

Daviess County Right To Life held its first Banquet in November of 1977 with Wayne Smith as the Speaker, and it was held at the Plainville Lions Club Building in Plainville. We have held a banquet each year since that time, and this has become the highlight of the year for the organization as hundreds of pro-life people come together to renew their effort in the fight against abortion in this country. After the first Banquet was held in Plainville the Banquet was then held at Washington High School for two years and then moved to the Ruritan Building in Montgomery for the next 26 of 27 years with the exception of the Gasthof Restaurant in 1997 before moving to the Simon J. Graber Building which will be the third year. Each time it was moved to accommodate the larger crowds that attend the Banquets.

In 1980 Daviess County RTL was put on the Map when our Banquet was held at the Montgomery Ruritan Building as Dr. Jack Willke and Barb Willke spoke to the nearly 500 who attended this event. The Pro-Life Movement was just coming on the National scene, and National CBS sent a film crew from Chicago to cover this event. The State Right To Life President attended along with Dan Quayle who was running against Senator Birch Bayh made a guest appearance. Film clips from this event were seen on National TV on the CBS Morning Show a day later. The reason the film crew came was to find out why the grass roots pro-life movement was growing so fast and to gage the impact it might have on the 1980 elections, and it did not take long to find out. The film crew could not

get over the large crowd that attended in this rural area and was impressed with Southern Indiana Hospitality. Future Banquet Speakers have included major names in the pro-life movement and national figures.

Daviess County Right To Life Organization has been instrumental in helping other Right To Life Groups in our area to form or to give them a helping hand either with donations or with organizational help for their organization. Daviess County Right To Life has been very much involved on the State Level as our local President has not only served as State President but has served on the National Right To Life Board of Directors representing Indiana. Daviess Co. RTL has not only been active in our local area but have been active on the State and Federal level as well. Daviess County Right To Life Organization does not receive funding grants or donations from State or Federal organizations of any kind. The only sources of income for the Organization is from donations from its members and Paper Drives which was started back in 1978 and continues to this day. Daviess Co. RTL opened an office on Main Street in Washington in the early part of 1998, and thru the efforts of then President Donna Gentry opened the Pregnancy Care Center in January of 1999. The Center has now grown where it has its own identity and office staff and serves hundreds of individuals each year. The Pregnancy Care Center and Daviess County Right To Life Organization now share offices in the lower level of the Grace Baptist Church on Troy Road in Washington.

In the years of existence Daviess County Right To Life has only had three Presidents, Bob Johnson from 1976 to 1978, Louis Kavanaugh Jr. from 1978-1995, Donna Gentry from 1995 to 2006 and Louie Kavanaugh Jr. has returned to the office of President in January of 2007 to the present time. Daviess County Right to Life has been very blessed with so many dedicated people who have given so much of their time and effort for the organization. Daviess County RTL has promoted life and worked against abortion thru Radio and Newspaper ads, Booths at Fairs and Montgomery Turkey Trot, put on programs at churches and schools and have lobbied our elected officials to support pro-life legislation. Although we are small in numbers, we have individuals who give it their all for the organization.

Our Organization was hit hard in January of 2011 while honoring Donna Gentry with a Memorial Bench at the site of the First Pregnancy Care Center She suddenly took ill and died a few days later. It was a shock to the organization and to her family and friends who knew her well. She was the founder of the Pregnancy Care Center and served as President of the Daviess Co. RTL for 1995-2006 and worked tireless for the organization. Many projects she undertook was a real shot in the arm not only to the organization but to the pro-life movement. She ran for State Representative on two occasions and nearly upset a long term incumbent in her first try for public office.

Although we have made history in the past, we truly hope the history we make in the future will be that all lives of the unborn are protected from conception to natural death. May God Bless our all of us in our work and Bless our Country!

Bethany Christian Church, Near Montgomery, Site Where Daviess Co. RTL Held Meeting for Many Years



The picture above of the old Bethany Christian Church west of Montgomery on Hwy 50 was taken just two days before the church was taken down. This was the site where Daviess County Right To Life held its meetings for many years. After the first meeting was held at the YMCA in Washington the meetings were moved to Bethany Church in 1976. Ben Bean who was the Pastor there for over 40 years invited the Right To Life to hold their meetings at the church and Ben Bean became the Vice President and held that position for many years. Ben & Eva Bean were very hospitable to the Right to Life members, and many lasting friendships were made because of Ben's invitation to the Right To Life.

When Donna Gentry took over as President, and the Pregnancy Care Center was started in January of 1999, the meetings were then moved to the Main Street location of the PCC on Main Street in Washington. After the building sold, the Right To Life & the PCC were moved to 608 West Walnut Street in September of 2004. In November of 2008 the Right To Life and the PCC moved to the present location on 705 Troy Road in the lower level of the Grace Baptist Church. They are very pleased with the location and the facilities.

It was sad to see the church taken down, but the membership of the church had grown so much they built a new church on highway 57 south of Washington. The old church was taken down on Monday August 11, and it took several days for the clean up. The old site of Bethany Christian Church will always have a soft spot in our hearts, and we will remember Ben & Eva Bean and the many hours we worked together on the many functions for Daviess RTL and the Support they gave us. We will always remember those dedicated members who worked so hard to start Daviess County Right To Life, especially the Wichman Family who are too nummerous to name here. We will always remember those early days and thank those who gave so much in the fight against Abortion. God Bless Them!

Daviess County Right to Life Discontinued Paper Drives but Will Still Have Aluminum Can Drives:

From 1978-2021, paper drives were a mainstay of Daviess County Right to Life's fundraising efforts, even becoming the main source of income for the organization at times.


Bernie Wichman, one of the original organizers behind the paper drive, was a cornerstone of the events, held the first Saturday of every even-numbered month, for 24 years. When his health failed and he passed away that same year, his son, Mike Wichman, stepped up to continue the work. Chuck and Steve Wichman, Mike's brothers, assisted faithfully as well for many years, following in the footsteps of Bernie Wichman and his brothers Bill and Bob.

Folks who helped with the paper drives remember Bernie Wichman's wife Alma bringing food for the workers, a tradition carried on by her daughter Mary Jo Sellers (Wichman). Mary Jo was faithfully involved with the Right to Life, holding the position of treasurer for the organization for many years. From their beginning in 1978 at the Washington Catholic School parking lot, paper drives were held in several Washington locations and other touch points around the county before coming to an end in 2021. Over the years, the amount of newspaper and aluminum cans has been exponential, often filling a semi in a single drive. Thousands of tons of paper have been spared from the landfill, in the process helping the cause of Daviess County Right to Life.

Donna Gentry leaves a long list of accomplishments, not only in the Right To Life and the Pregnancy Care Center, but also in other community organizations. Placing the Bench/Monument at the site where the Pregnancy Care Center was founded in January of 1999 was done by Daviess County Right To Life Organization to highlight the significance of that endeavor. This bench would also honor Donna Gentry who was the founder of the Pregnancy Care Center and honor the many lives she has been able to touch, the many people she has helped and for her many accomplishments in the pro-life movement. The work of the Pregnancy Care Center would not have been possible without the dedication of Donna Gentry to see it through.

Ever so often you come across an individual who has made such a huge impact on their community, and this has been evident in Donna Gentry's passing. The impact by Gentry was evident by the many people who paid their respects and to the large crowd who attended her Funeral. Donna's Granddaughter Brianne Rainey said it best as she ended her remarks at the Funeral. "We remember her as a great woman, but she wasn't, she was a simple woman that did great things through Jesus."

Donna's spirit will live on in the pro-life work she has started. We will never forget the contribution she has made to the unborn!
