President Trump Signs Pardons for 23 Pro-Life Americans

President Donald Trump has signed an executive order pardoning the 23 pro-life Americans Joe Biden imprisoned for protesting abortion. "This is a great honor to sign this," Trump said, condemning Biden's lawfare, especially targeted at "elderly people."

Trump granted pardons for 23 pro-life advocates who faced weaponized prosecutions brought against them by the Biden Department of Justice under the Freedom of Access to Clinic Entrances (FACE) Act.

Earlier this month, Thomas More Society attorneys submitted to the Trump administration formal requests for presidential pardons on behalf of 21 of those pro-life advocates who have been unjustly prosecuted, convicted, and in several cases, imprisoned, by the Biden DOJ. In their letter submitted to President Donald J. Trump, Thomas More Society attorneys urged "that these pro-life Americans are deserving of full and unconditional pardons." The communicated pardon request package included 21 individual pardon requests, one for each pro-life advocate, outlining the specific facts of each case, their upstanding personal and moral character, and the reasons why President Trump should grant a presidential pardon.

The president also addressed the March for Life participants via a video message.

As LifeNews has extensively reported, pro-life activists await pardons from President Donald Trump after Biden mis-

used the FACE Act and other laws to put them in prison for minor trespassing misdemeanors.

"Today, freedom rings in our great nation. The heroic peaceful pro-lifers unjustly imprisoned by Biden's Justice Department will now be freed and able to return home to their families, eat a family meal, and enjoy the freedom that should have never been taken from them in the first place," reacted Steve Crampton, Thomas More Society Senior Counsel. "These heroic peaceful pro-lifers were treated shamefully by Biden's DOJ, with many of them branded felons and losing many rights that we take for granted as American citizens. Today, their precious freedom is restored. What happened to them can never be erased, but today's pardons are a huge step towards restoring justice. Thank you to President Trump and his team for righting these grievous wrongs of the previous administration."

"Today is a new day for the pardoned pro-life advocates who have suffered FBI raids, federal prosecutions, and severe punishment for peacefully and courageously witnessing for life. We thank President Trump for keeping his promise to these pro-life mothers, fathers, grandparents, pastors, and priests," added Peter Breen, Thomas More Society Executive Vice President and Head of Litigation. "What happened to these peaceful pro-life individuals must never happen again. We urge Congress to act swiftly in repealing the FACE Act to make sure that **continued** on PAGE 7

President Trump Takes First Step to Overturn Joe Biden's Abortion Agenda By Ben Johnson, LifeNews

A mong its first acts in office, the Trump-Vance administration closed a federal government website opened by the Biden administration to promote abortion-on-demand at taxpayers' expense. Users noted the website ReproductiveRights. gov had gone offline on Monday afternoon, shortly after Chief Justice John Roberts swore in Donald Trump as the 47th president of the United States.

"Reproductive healthcare, including access to birth control and safe and legal abortion care, is an essential part of your health and well-being," the moribund website claimed. It also erroneously insisted the abortion pill, mifepristone, "is safe and effective when used as directed," although mifepristone produced 35 emergency room visits for every 100 abortions in 2015.

The Biden-Harris administration announced the website's debut on August 3, 2022, in response to the Supreme Court's pro-life ruling in Dobbs v. Jackson Women's Health Organization. The website came amid a flurry of measures to promote abortion-on-demand in spite of the Supreme Court ruling. The administration also formed the Reproductive Rights Task Force, led by then-Associate Attorney General Vanita Gupta, inside the Justice Department to crack down on peaceful side-walk counselors. The federal page linked to a website that referred readers to a list of abortionists in their state or region. "If you need help paying for an abortion, abortion funds may be able to provide financial assistance," the federal website stated. Pro-life advocates greeted the taxpayer-funded website's closure with enthusiasm. "Could this be the start of Making America Pro-Life Again?!" asked Kristan Hawkins of Students for Life of America. "Let's go!" enthused the Texas Alliance for Life.

The website went offline the same day news broke that Cecile Richards, the CEO of Planned Parenthood Federation of America from 2006 to 2018, died at the age of 67 from a glioblastoma, an aggressive form of brain cancer. During her 12 years leading the nation's largest abortion business, "Richards increased the number of abortions Planned Parenthood carried out each year by almost 70,000," wrote Mary Szoch, director of the Center for Human Dignity at Family Research Council.

Richards presided over Planned Parenthood when undercover investigative journalists David Daleiden and Sandra Merritt exposed the group's harvesting and sale of aborted babies' organs and tissue. Richards's replacement, Leana Wen, advocated for vaccine passports during the COVID-19 pandemic shortly after leaving Planned Parenthood to become a CNN analyst.

This Baby Was Saved from Abortion When a Doctor Reversed the Abortion Pill Gayle Irwin, LifeNews

Sierra felt as though her life was like a tornado, a whirlwind spinning out of control. Her husband had walked out on her and their four children. She wasn't sure how she was going to care for her young family. Add to these stresses the unexpected loss of her sister.

"I was almost in survival mode," Sierra said.

Sierra sought comfort with

a man and became pregnant.

Fear overtook the Ohio woman, and she made an appointment at a Planned Parenthood two hours away from her home.

"I felt like this was my only option," she said. However, she said she prayed for a sign, for something that would tell her to turn around and not go through with the abortion. But she felt and saw nothing.

When she walked into the abortion facility, she saw 20 or more women waiting.

"It was quiet," she said of the atmosphere. "Nobody's speaking, no one is on their phones. It was just a very, very heavy feeling." Sierra was told the first pill she took would stop her unborn child's heartbeat, and when she asked if "it would look like a baby" when she "passed it," the person at the abortion center said, 'No.' Sierra believed she was about 10 weeks along.

After taking the first pill, grief and regret overwhelmed her.

"I wanted to cut it out of my throat," she recalled. "I felt like I really messed up."

Sierra said she contacted her OB-GYN and asked if there was something that could be done to stop the abortion pill from taking effect, and her doctor told her there was nothing she could do.

Sierra felt remorse for making the decision to abort her child. As she left the Planned Parenthood parking lot, she noticed a sign on the ground. She stopped to read it.

"It said, 'If you've taken the first pill, it's not too late," Sierra said. "There was the sign I was looking for."

She went online and searched the internet using the exact wording she read, and the Abortion Pill Rescue[®] Network (APRN) captured her attention. She called the hotline number and asked for information, explaining she was "in a bad place."

"And the sweetest voice on the phone said, 'We can help you," Sierra said.

Finding hope

She was connected to **Pregnancy Decision Health Centers** (PDHC) in Columbus, Ohio, one of hundreds of pregnancy medical clinics around the country that offers Abortion Pill Reversal (APR) services and the closest to where she lived. One of the nurses spoke with her on the phone and offered to pray with



her, noting "it's a critical and beautiful time" to interact with women learning about APR. That prayer made an impact on Sierra.

"There was no shame, no condemnation," Sierra said in a video message for PDHC. "It was just, 'Are you okay?' And that's huge." An appointment was made for Sierra to visit PDHC the next day for an ultrasound and to determine if

the baby still had a heartbeat. She was told the staff would be praying for her and her baby, and that night, Sierra also prayed for her child to live.

"There is hope and help available, and we are here to answer any questions, provide support and connect any woman seeking reversal with the care she needs to attempt to continue her pregnancy," said Christa Brown, BSN, RN, senior director of Medical Impact for Heartbeat International. Heartbeat manages the APRN, a network of more than 1,400 healthcare professionals, pregnancy centers, hospitals, and pharmacists that administer the APR protocol.

APR works by countering the effects of the first abortion pill mifepristone with progesterone, the hormone in a pregnant woman's system necessary for pregnancy to thrive. It is an updated application of a decades-old treatment used to combat miscarriage. "Our network has assisted women in 93 different countries and all states in the U.S.," she said. "Our data shows more than 5,000 women have successfully reversed mifepristone and had healthy children."

In addition to the efficacy, Brown remarked on the safety of APR treatment. "Since the progesterone counteracts the harmful effects of the mifepristone, we do not see ill effects on the mothers and no increased birth defects for the babies born after successful reversal," she said, Sierra's little girl is one of those thousands of babies saved from abortion by APR.

The little one in the womb did have a heartbeat when Sierra went to PDHC the day after calling the APRN hotline number. "God's goodness," Sierra pondered … "He didn't have to let me keep her."


APR and answered prayer

PDHC staff put her on progesterone per the APR protocol and checked on her for several weeks through phone calls and text messages. The center covered Sierra and her unborn baby in prayer. That support and care also positively impacted Sierra, and her doctor, who didn't know about APR at the time, was happy at the outcome as well.

"She couldn't wait to deliver her," Sierra recalled. "She was astounded."

Poll Confirms Majority of Americans Support Pro-Life Policies

On January 23, the Knights of Columbus released their annual poll on sanctity-of-life issues. This poll, which the Knights conduct in conjunction with Marist College, is always welcomed by pro-lifers.

Unlike other surveys conducted by professional survey research firms, the Knights of Columbus/Marist poll asks about conscience rights, pregnancy help centers, and other issues of particular interest to people in the pro-life movement. Very often, the Knights of Columbus/Marist poll shows very strong public support for a range of incremental pro-life laws.

This year's poll was no exception. The Knights of Columbus/Marist poll found that, among over 1,387 adults surveyed, clear majorities opposed taxpayer funding of abortion both at home and overseas. Conscience rights polled well, as 62 percent felt that medical professionals should not be legally required to perform abortions.

Additionally, 63 percent of Americans felt that an in-person medical exam should be required if a woman wants to obtain a chemical abortion. Finally, a whopping 83 percent of adults support the work of pro-life pregnancy help centers.

Overall, the Knights of Columbus/Marist poll revealed a great deal of stability in public attitudes toward abortion during the past year. Interestingly, the poll found gains in public support for some pro-life policies. There was greater opposition to public funding of abortion both at home and abroad. Since 2024, there has been a gain of two percentage points in support of conscience rights of health care professionals.

This is important. During the 2024 election, Kamala Harris and other Democrats clearly prioritized abortion, spending millions of dollars on the issue. This poll shows that support for many pro-life policies is very durable.

As pro-lifers return home from Friday's March for Life, we should take heart. During his first few days in office, President Trump has taken some valuable steps in building a culture of life. He has pardoned the 23 pro-lifers who were jailed for FACE Act violations. He has also restored the Mexico City policy, which prevents U.S. foreign aid dollars from going to overseas entities that perform or promote abortions. This new Knights of Columbus/Marist poll contains more good news. It shows the incoming Trump administration that potential policy steps to strengthen conscience rights and limit chemical abortions will enjoy strong public support.

NBC Refuses to Cover March for Life Despite 100,000 Participants

A charitable analysis of ABC, NBC, and CBS's Friday evening and Saturday morning broadcasts would find that the six shows combined to give the 52nd annual March for Life in Washington, D.C., a measly 48 seconds of coverage.

Neither ABC's Saturday edition of *Good Morning America*, NBC's *Today*, nor CBS *Saturday Morning* acknowledged the rally's existence, meaning all the coverage came on Friday evening.

NBC Nightly News also skipped the rally altogether, giving NBC zero combined seconds. Still, zero seconds is somehow an improvement for NBC because last year, not only did they omit the March for Life, they actively promoted pro-abortion high schoolers.

CBS Evening News was only aired on the West Coast due to golf coverage and on the network's online streaming service. Host Nancy Cordes only gave the rally 21 seconds, "Thousands of anti-abortion rights activists converged on the nation's capital today for the annual March for Life. President Trump addressed the crowd in a video while Vice President JD Vance spoke in person. Activists are encouraged by Trump's election victory and his decision to pardon protesters who blocked access to abortion clinics."

Meanwhile, ABC *World News Tonight* anchor David Muir found 27 seconds to discuss the rally, "In Washington today, thousands of people turned out for the annual March for Life rally. The first march since Republicans won the White House and both houses of Congress and 24 hours after President Trump issued full pardons to 23 anti-abortion rights activists convicted of blockading abortion clinics. Vice President Vance and Congressional leaders addressed the crowd. In a prerecorded message, Trump pledged to push for further restrictions on abortion."

What Muir and Cordes left out of their mentions of Trump's pardons is that the Biden Administration not only went after communist gulag survivors and other elderly protesters but insisted on harsher-than-usual sentences in order to make a point.

those pro-life activists in jail in the first place. President Trump made a video appearance at the March for Life Rally and Vice President Vance spoke in person as his first official appearance as Vice President.

These actions to protect life in the first week of the new administration have breathed life into the pro-life movement. They are key victories to celebrate, while also acknowledging more work remains. The Administration must make it a priority to foster our nation's great strength: families and children.

To build upon these common sense moves, here are key priorities that must be addressed this year: Title X Reform

The Title X grant program should no longer be a backdoor for federal funding of abortion providers. Most American taxpayers oppose their money being used to support abortion. Abortion undermines the American family, weakens communities, and fuels criminal activities like human trafficking and domestic violence. A strong nation begins with strong families, and these policies reflect that truth.

Protect Pro-Life Americans from Discrimination

The Biden administration weaponized the Department of Justice against pro-life advocates, creating an environment of fear and hostility. To reverse this, the Trump administration should stop the weaponization of the FACE Act once and for all. Pro-life Americans should never be persecuted for their values.

Federal Funding for Pregnancy Centers

Pregnancy help centers and maternity homes provide irreplaceable support to women navigating unplanned pregnancies. These centers are vital lifelines, offering compassionate care, practical resources, and emotional encouragement that empower women to choose life and build bright futures. Unlike abortion clinics, these pregnancy centers do not financially benefit from a woman's decision and yet are often the targets of attack and smear campaigns. Instituting federal funding for basic services will ensure these centers can expand their impact, continuing to serve as trusted pillars of hope and support for countless women and families.

A New Vision for Supporting Women

To solidify his legacy, President Trump must go beyond reinstating previous policies. His administration can simultaneously protect unborn life and send a strong, unwavering message of support to women. It is not an either-or stance; both goals can and should coexist.

According to a Guttmacher Institute study, a staggering 73% of women cite financial concerns as a major factor in their decision to seek an abortion. Confronting these realities requires comprehensive social policies and cultural dialogue that recognizes the complexities of unplanned pregnancies. Instead of establishing task forces and websites to promote abortion access as the Biden administration did, President Trump should replace these initiatives with programs that provide meaningful support to women and ensure they are widely publicized through robust public awareness campaigns. Expanding the role of pregnancy centers and maternity homes and equipping them with the resources to effectively serve women in their communities must also be a central focus. The Biden-Harris administration has not prosecuted anyone under the FACE Act for the 436 church attacks that took place last year, even though pro-life pregnancy resource centers are 22 times more likely to be attacked than abortion facilities.

"While Biden's prosecutors almost entirely ignored the firebombing and vandalism of hundreds of pro-life churches and pregnancy centers, they viciously pursued pro-life Americans, obtaining convictions against them under the federal 'FACE Act' and the Ku Klux Klan Act's 'Conspiracy Against Rights' felony provisions. But these individuals participated in mere peaceable civil disobedience, in the heralded tradition of the American Civil Rights activists.

Peaceable actions like these usually merit, at worst, a minor misdemeanor conviction," it states. These prosecutions represent a significant escalation of lawfare and weaponization of government against Christians. "Neither the Clinton DOJ nor the Obama DOJ dared use this plainly inapplicable law against pro-life advocates."

Erin Hawley, senior counsel for the religious legal advocacy firm Alliance Defending Freedom, told the *Washington Examiner* that the FACE act "was completely weaponized by the Biden DOJ."
