Missy Martinez-Stone, Working to Hold Abortion Clinics Accountable!



Daviess/Pike and Martin County Right to Life Groups would like to welcome Missy Martinez-Stone as the 2025 Right to Life Banquet Speaker for their Annual Banquet.

She is a nationally recognized expert on ensuring the accountability of abortion facilities for their unsafe and illegal practices, ultimately leading to their closure. In 2018, she was asked to help develop an innovative women's advocacy organization, resulting in the launch of Reprotection in January 2020. Their organization has since evolved

into the Center for Client Safety, with Missy Martinez-Stone serving as the President and CEO.

Through her dedicated efforts, Missy has played a pivotal role in suspending the operations of four abortion facilities within the past two years while concurrently spearheading ongoing investigations in more than 30 states

Previously, Missy served as the National Field Director for Students for Life of America, where she doubled the number of student groups served and facilitated Students for Life in equipping over 1,000 student groups. Additionally, Missy served on the board of Choices Women's Center, a pregnancy center in Fredericksburg, VA. Her expertise and achievements have garnered media attention, with features in prominent outlets such as the New York Times, the Washington Post, Associated Press, the Christian Broadcasting Network, and numerous other media platforms. Joe and I met in 2009 and married in 2012. Joe came as a package deal and I gained an amazing bonus son, Peyton who is now a student at Purdue. Less than one year after Joe and I married, I was diagnosed with endometrial cancer and had a total hysterectomy. I was blessed to be a stepmother and help raise Peyton since age 3, but still wanted the experience to raise a baby who would call me mom. I had known I would have fertility struggles, but the cancer diagnosis was a shattering, definitive blow.

A friend and coworker generously offered to be a surrogate for me. I was so touched and blown away by the offer, but I declined, knowing God had other plans. There were plenty of children who needed a family. Joe was adopted and was given an amazing life by his mom Debbie, so the topic had come up before.

Shortly after my surgery, I started seeing signs posted everywhere about fostering and the topic of fostering repeatedly presented itself via conversations that came up, people I knew who were fostering, and even television. I knew God was speaking to me, so we talked about it. The thought was overwhelming (especially for Joe who said we could just take one child haha), but we both decided to dive in and got licensed. I had so much fun decorating a nursery and buying all the baby things. I couldn't wait to get the call from DCS!

Soon we got an 11 week old baby boy placed with us (Brody). I was at work when he arrived and I couldn't wait to get home! It was surreal having this sweet baby to love on. We all fell in love with him so fast. The attachment was immediate. A few weeks later, we were presented with the opportunity of a private adoption. My best friend (who was the nurse for my gynecologist) had a patient wanting to put her baby girl up for adoption and she was due in 5 weeks! I called Joe from work to tell him expecting him to say no and that

we already had a baby (who may not get to stay). To my surprise, he said “Let’s do it!”

My best friend and Doctor told her about us and she called that night. We met quickly after and she decided we were a good fit. I even got to go to an appointment and hear her heartbeat. A few weeks later, she went into early labor and I drove her to the hospital and was present for the C-section. The feeling of being an official mother was overwhelming. I cried happy tears for us, and grieving tears for how hard it must have been for Millie’s bio-mom.

She gave me the greatest gift I could ever receive. Our adoption was final shortly before Christmas.

We had received two babies within 3 months! Now those babies are 7 years old and thriving. We have kept in touch with Millie’s bio-mother and we send pictures although the adoption is closed. We are forever grateful to Millie’s bio-mom who selflessly carried her to term and entrusted us with her child she couldn’t care for. I am so glad she knew how special her baby was and let her have a chance.

Brody was our first foster placement (besides respite care we had provided to other foster parents). His mother eventually signed away her rights knowing we could provide a better life for him. He was two on his official “gotcha day” and we were surrounded by family and friends and all wore matching t-shirts to Court. It was the best day of my life. Our family was complete. We have a great relationship with Brody’s bio-grandparents and aunts and love them dearly. DCS had asked that we meet with the grandparents when adoption was in the works and we hit it off instantly. They treat us all like part of the family. They are family.

I had kept praying that God would send me a child who could stay and He delivered not one, but two precious gifts! Two more children were not part of Joe’s plan, but he couldn’t love them anymore than his own biological son. I still can’t believe how blessed we were and are. They truly are miracles and we can’t imagine life without the two of them. They have such potential and so many special gifts. This world is and will be a better place because they had a chance at life.

We remain eternally grateful to God and to the fact that This Mother chose adoption, not abortion.

HISTORY OF DAVIESS COUNTY RIGHT TO LIFE INC.

The Daviess County Right To Life Organization was founded in November of 1976 when a small group of people met and decided it was time to form an organization in Daviess County to promote life and work to overturn the Roe vs. Wade Decision which legalized abortion in 1973. A group from Evansville was instrumental in helping our organization get started. Some of the individuals from Daviess County helping to form the organization was Bob Johnson Pastor of Plainville Christian Church along with Ben Ray & Eva Bean, Pastor of Bethany Christian Church, along with Bernie & Alma Wichman, Bill & Josephine Wichman, Margaret Wichman and Vic Hopkins. Bob Johnson became the first president of the organization.

Daviess County Right To Life held its first Banquet in November of 1977 with Wayne Smith as the Speaker, and it was held at the Plainville Lions Club Building in Plainville. We have held a banquet each year since that time, and this has become the highlight of the year for the organization as hundreds of pro-life people come together to renew their effort in the fight against abortion in this country. After the first Banquet was held in Plainville the Banquet was then held at Washington High School for two years and then moved to the Ruritan Building in Montgomery for the next 26 of 27 years with the exception of the Gasthof Restaurant in 1997 before moving to the Simon J. Graber Building which will be the third year. Each time it was moved to accommodate the larger crowds that attend the Banquets.

In 1980 Daviess County RTL was put on the Map when our Banquet was held at the Montgomery Ruritan Building as Dr. Jack Willke and Barb Willke spoke to the nearly 500 who attended this event. The Pro-Life Movement was just coming on the National scene, and National CBS sent a film crew from Chicago to cover this event. The State Right To Life President attended along with Dan Quayle who was running against Senator Birch Bayh made a guest appearance. Film clips from this event were seen on National TV on the CBS Morning Show a day later. The reason the film crew came was to find out why the grass roots pro-life movement was growing so fast and to gage the impact it might have on the 1980 elections, and it did not take long to find out. The film crew could not

get over the large crowd that attended in this rural area and was impressed with Southern Indiana Hospitality. Future Banquet Speakers have included major names in the pro-life movement and national figures.

Daviess County Right To Life Organization has been instrumental in helping other Right To Life Groups in our area to form or to give them a helping hand either with donations or with organizational help for their organization. Daviess County Right To Life has been very much involved on the State Level as our local President has not only served as State President but has served on the National Right To Life Board of Directors representing Indiana. Daviess Co. RTL has not only been active in our local area but have been active on the State and Federal level as well. Daviess County Right To Life Organization does not receive funding grants or donations from State or Federal organizations of any kind. The only sources of income for the Organization is from donations from its members and Paper Drives which was started back in 1978 and continues to this day. Daviess Co. RTL opened an office on Main Street in Washington in the early part of 1998, and thru the efforts of then President Donna Gentry opened the Pregnancy Care Center in January of 1999. The Center has now grown where it has its own identity and office staff and serves hundreds of individuals each year. The Pregnancy Care Center and Daviess County Right To Life Organization now share offices in the lower level of the Grace Baptist Church on Troy Road in Washington.

In the years of existence Daviess County Right To Life has only had three Presidents, Bob Johnson from 1976 to 1978, Louis Kavanaugh Jr. from 1978-1995, Donna Gentry from 1995 to 2006 and Louie Kavanaugh Jr. has returned to the office of President in January of 2007 to the present time. Daviess County Right to Life has been very blessed with so many dedicated people who have given so much of their time and effort for the organization. Daviess County RTL has promoted life and worked against abortion thru Radio and Newspaper ads, Booths at Fairs and Montgomery Turkey Trot, put on programs at churches and schools and have lobbied our elected officials to support pro-life legislation. Although we are small in numbers, we have individuals who give it their all for the organization.

Our Organization was hit hard in January of 2011 while honoring Donna Gentry with a Memorial Bench at the site of the First Pregnancy Care Center She suddenly took ill and died a few days later. It was a shock to the organization and to her family and friends who knew her well. She

was the founder of the Pregnancy Care Center and served as President of the Daviess Co. RTL for 1995-2006 and worked tirelessly for the organization. Many projects she undertook was a real shot in the arm not only to the organization but to the pro-life movement. She ran for State Representative on two occasions and nearly upset a long term incumbent in her first try for public office.

Although we have made history in the past, we truly hope the history we make in the future will be that all lives of the unborn are protected from conception to natural death. May God Bless our all of us in our work and Bless our Country!

Bethany Christian Church, Near Montgomery, Site Where Daviess Co. RTL Held Meeting for Many Years



The picture above of the old Bethany Christian Church west of Montgomery on Hwy 50 was taken just two days before the church was taken down. This was the site where Daviess County Right To Life held its meetings for many years. After the first meeting was held at the YMCA in Washington the meetings were moved to Bethany Church in 1976. Ben Bean who was the Pastor there for over 40 years invited the Right To Life to hold their meetings at the church and Ben Bean became the Vice President and held that position for many years. Ben & Eva Bean were very hospitable to the Right to Life members, and many lasting friendships were made because of Ben's invitation to the Right To Life.

When Donna Gentry took over as President, and the Pregnancy Care Center was started in January of 1999, the meetings were then moved to the Main Street location of the PCC on Main Street in Washington. After the building sold, the Right To Life & the PCC were moved to 608 West Walnut Street in September of 2004. In November of 2008 the Right To Life and the PCC moved to the present location on 705 Troy Road in the lower level of the Grace Baptist Church. They are very pleased with the location and the facilities.

It was sad to see the church taken down, but the membership of the church had grown so much they built a new church on highway 57 south of Washington. The old church was taken down on Monday August 11, and it took several days for the clean up. The old site of Bethany Christian Church will always have a soft spot in our hearts, and we will remember Ben & Eva Bean and the many hours we worked together on the many functions for Daviess RTL and the Support they gave us. We will always remember those dedicated members who worked so hard to start Daviess County Right To Life, especially the Wichman Family who are too numerous to name here. We will always remember those early days and thank those who gave so much in the fight against Abortion. God Bless Them!

Daviess County Right to Life Discontinued Paper Drives but Will Still Have Aluminum Can Drives:



On Dec. 4, 2021 the Daviess County Right to Life held their last Paper Drive after more than 40 years of recycling newsprint. You can see here the picture of Mike Wichman as he closes the door of the semi-trailer for the last time. From 1978-2021, paper drives were a mainstay of Daviess County Right to Life’s fundraising efforts, even becoming the main source of income for the organization at times.

Bernie Wichman, one of the original organizers behind the paper drive, was a cornerstone of the events, held the first Saturday of every even-numbered month, for 24 years. When his health failed and he passed away that same year, his son, Mike Wichman, stepped up to continue the work. Chuck and Steve Wichman, Mike’s brothers, assisted faithfully as well for many years, following in the footsteps of Bernie Wichman and his brothers Bill and Bob.

Folks who helped with the paper drives remember Bernie Wichman’s wife Alma bringing food for the workers, a tradition carried on by her daughter Mary Jo Sellers (Wichman). Mary Jo was faithfully involved with the Right to Life, holding the position of treasurer for the organization for many years. From their beginning in 1978 at the Washington Catholic School parking lot, paper drives were held in several Washington locations and other touch points around the county before coming to an end in 2021. Over the years, the amount of newspaper and aluminum cans has been exponential, often filling a semi in a single drive. Thousands of tons of paper have been spared from the landfill, in the process helping the cause of Daviess County Right to Life.

Donna suffered a massive stroke towards the end of the ceremony and was taken to the hospital and passed away five days later on Wednesday afternoon, February 2. She was laid to rest on Saturday, February 5.

Donna Gentry leaves a long list of accomplishments, not only in the Right To Life and the Pregnancy Care Center, but also in other community organizations. Placing the Bench/Monument at the site where the Pregnancy Care Center was founded in January of 1999 was done by Daviess County Right To Life Organization to highlight the significance of that endeavor. This bench would also honor Donna Gentry who was the founder of the Pregnancy Care Center and honor the many lives she has been able to touch, the many people she has helped and for her many accomplishments in the pro-life movement. The work of the Pregnancy Care Center would not have been possible without the dedication of Donna Gentry to see it through.

Ever so often you come across an individual who has made such a huge impact on their community, and this has been evident in Donna Gentry's passing. The impact by Gentry was evident by the many people who paid their respects and to the large crowd who attended her Funeral. Donna's Granddaughter Brianne Rainey said it best as she ended her remarks at the Funeral. **"We remember her as a great woman, but she wasn't, she was a simple woman that did great things through Jesus."**

Donna's spirit will live on in the pro-life work she has started.

“What is happening to America because of abortion?”

As our world continues to get progressively farther from the original church teachings, abortion sticks out as an impending, and typically controversial, issue. In the society we live in, people tend to claim they believe in a religion, but then pick and choose which of the religion's beliefs they actually want to follow. In addition, people tend to make excuses for abortion to be right in certain circumstances. The Issue of whether abortion should be allowed or not has become one of the most prominent political issues, being one of the leading causes division amongst the citizens of the United States. “What is happening to America because of abortion?”

Since *Roe v. Wade* in 1973, there have been over 60 million abortions in America. That number is hard to even picture. That's not just a statistic that's millions of future teachers, athletes, doctors, moms, and dads. Think of all the things they could've done. Our country was built by people with big dreams and strong values, but we've taken away so many chances for greatness by not protecting the unborn. Abortion doesn't just affect the babies who never get to be born—it also affects the women who go through it. A lot of them are scared and feel like they don't have another option.

Some are told it's the easy way out, but later they're left with pain and regret that lasts a long time. I think instead of pushing abortion, we should offer real support, help with raising the child or finding a loving adoptive family. That's what true care and compassion look like. I also believe how we view abortion is connected to how we treat life in general. If we start deciding that some lives aren't worth living because they're hard or inconvenient, that thinking can spill into other areas like how we treat the elderly, the sick, or people with disabilities. Life should always be protected, no matter the situation.

What gives me hope is seeing more people my age stand up for life. Being pro-life isn't just about being against abortion it's about speaking up for those who can't, offering love in hard situations, and building a culture where every life is valued and supported.

America is supposed to be a place where everyone has the chance to live freely and chase their dreams. But that promise doesn't mean much if we don't even give people the chance to be born. It's time we do better not just by ending abortion, but by creating a world where no one feels like they have to choose it.
