She pointed to the abortion pill that can be order on line that is dangerous for women to take. Deaths have occurred because there is no doctor to monitor the young mothers as they take in the privacy of their home. She said we must work to change the minds and hearts of these young mothers and mentor to them. You are doing the right thing here in your community by having a Pregnancy Resource Center in your area to help pregnant mothers in an unplanned pregnancy. Indiana Right to Life President & CEO Mike Fichter was also present for the Banquet and gave an update on what is happening on the state level. He stated Indiana has some of the strictest laws on abortion but worries about the abortion pills coming into the state. Hamdan Family Selected as 2025 Adoptive Family at Right to Life Banquet





Pope Leo's Scandalous Abortion Remarks Could Help Democrats: Here's How

For decades faithful American clergy and lay groups have fought to ensure that abortion is considered a preeminent moral evil. Pope Leo's comments effectively undo's all of that. For decades faithful clergy and Catholic lay groups have fought to ensure that abortion is considered a preeminent moral evil when it comes to politics and voting in America. Against them have stood dissident Catholic websites, bloggers, and Democratic lawmakers who seek to diminish its elevated status in order to justify supporting their left-wing ideology.

Pope Leo's comments effectively undo those years of hard work. In making them, he essentially justified Nancy Pelosi, Joe Biden, and others who have flouted the Church's moral teaching for decades as his comments are almost word for word the arguments they have repeatedly used.

Leo's remarks also serve to undermine the many courageous priests and bishops who for years warned these and other liberal Catholic lawmakers to amend their lives — and who barred them from Holy Communion for not doing so. But now they have just been given the moral cover needed to continue ahead, without pain of conscience, to keep voting for pro-abortion, pro-LGBT, and open borders legislation.

But why wait to capitalize on Leo's remarks when that can be done now? Indeed, the political left has already started to use them to attack conservatives. Michael Steele, the GOP's former National Committee Chairman, appeared on MSNBC recently to discuss Leo's comments.

Despite working for the Republican Party in years past, Steele has turned into an anti-Trump activist in recent years, using his platform to criticize conservatives so he can look like a moderate to liberals. During his appearance, Steele praised Leo for his comments while arguing that they undermine Catholic Vice President JD Vance's support for Trump's deportation policies. Leo is indeed at odds with Vance on the subject. Make no mistake: the left will see to it that Leo's remarks are not memory-holed when Vance seeks the presidency in 2028.

Catholics must push back against Leo's remarks, as they falsely equate the grave evil of abortion with issues that do not reach that level of moral significance. Catholics should also call on him to amend his remarks and state that he adheres to the Church's long-standing teaching on the subject.

Editor's Note: Pope Leo does need to clarify his unfortunate statement. Otherwise, liberals who support abortion will continue to cite comments from the Pope to justify their pro-abortion actions. They will try to justify their backing of laws that end the lives of pre-born children. In the past other popes including Pope John Paul II did state that abortion is an extrinsic evil and should disqualify any person supporting abortion from public office. Now with Pope Leo making this confusing statement, it does not change the fact that supporting abortion should be a disqualifying factor when voting for any person for public office. We do hope Pope Leo will clean up his misstatement he made on this issue.

Pro-Choice Travel Advisory Passed in New Jersey

New Jersey Democrats' bill would establish a so-called 'reproductive health travel advisory' urging residents to 'reconsider travel' to states with abortion restrictions.

The New Jersey Legislature has passed a travel warning to alert residents about the difficulty they may have getting abortions when traveling to other states.

Assembly Bill 4915 would establish a so-called "reproductive health travel advisory" notifying residents about the "extent to which states within the United States restrict access to reproductive healthcare services," i.e., the murder of the unborn, through information about the abortion restrictions, funding options, or lack thereof in every other U.S. state.

States would be categorized as blue for no restrictions, yellow for "increased caution" due to "restricted access to [so-called] reproductive medical care that could result in civil or criminal prosecution," and red with a warning to "reconsider travel" due to "extremely restricted access" resulting in not only prosecution but also the supposed danger of "adverse medical outcome" (a common false charge against pro-life states).

Such amendments had great success in the first two years following *Dobbs*, further convincing many that America was solidifying in a more pro-abortion direction. But that too began

to change in 2024, when pro-lifers defeated pro-abortion ballot initiatives in three of the 10 states who had them on the ballot.

Since *Roe v. Wade's* fall, 12 states have banned all or most abortions. But the abortion lobby continues to work feverishly to cancel out those deterrents via deregulated interstate distribution of abortion pills, legal protection and financial support of interstate abortion travel, constructing new abortion facilities near borders shared by pro-life and pro-abortion states, making liberal states sanctuaries for those who want to evade or violate the laws of more pro-life neighbors, and embedding abortion "rights" in state constitutions.

Indiana U.S. Congressional Members Vote to Defund Planned Parenthood

Both US Senators Todd Young and Jim Banks voted to defund Planned Parenthood. In the House, two Democrats, Carson and Mrvan, voted no; but all seven Republicans voted to defund PP. This is catching on throughout the country.

Catholic Bishops take on Controversy After Scandal Over Durbin Award by Bishop Cupich *Steven Ertelt | Washington, DC*

The U.S. Conference of Catholic Bishops will convene next month to elect a new president and six committee chairmen, a routine vote overshadowed by a recent uproar over the Archdiocese of Chicago's plan to honor pro-abortion Senator Dick Durbin with a lifetime achievement award. The plenary assembly, set for November 10-12 in Baltimore, comes amid lingering fallout from the controversy, which drew sharp rebukes from several bishops who decried the recognition as a scandal undermining the church's core teachings on the sanctity of life. The elections will select a successor to Archbishop Timothy Broglio of the Archdiocese for the Military Services, USA, who has served as USCCB president since November 2022.

Also on the ballot are chairs for the committees on doctrine, domestic justice and human development, international justice and peace, laity, marriage, family life and youth, and migration. The vote follows a period of internal tension highlighted by the Chicago incident, where Cardinal Blase Cupich defended plans to present the award to Durbin, an Illinois Democrat, at a November 3 fundraiser for the archdiocese's immigration ministry. Cupich, in a September 22 statement, described the honor as recognition of Durbin's "singular contribution to immigration reform and his unwavering support of immigrants."

Durbin, a self-professed Catholic who has faced a Communion ban in his home diocese since 2004 for his radical pro-abortion stance, ultimately declined the award on September 30. Cupich expressed sadness over the decision but respect for it, reiterating that the gesture was tied to a "consistent ethic of life" that extends beyond any single issue.

"At the heart of the consistent ethic of life is the recognition that Catholic teaching on life and dignity cannot be reduced to a single issue, even an issue as important as abortion," Cupich said. The episode ignited widespread criticism from pro-life advocates and fellow bishops, who argued it confused the faithful and contradicted church doctrine prioritizing the protection of babies from abortion.

Bishop Thomas Paprocki of Springfield, Illinois — Durbin's home diocese — said he was "shocked" by the announcement. "Honoring a public figure who has actively worked to expand and entrench the right to end innocent human life in the womb undermines the very concept of human dignity and solidarity that the award purports to uphold," Paprocki said in a statement.

Paprocki, who enforced the Communion restriction on Durbin, urged Cupich to reconsider for the sake of "clarity, unity, and fidelity to the Gospel of Life." Archbishop Salvatore Cordileone of San Francisco voiced solidarity with Paprocki on social media, stating: "I stand in solidarity with Bishop Thomas Paprocki of Springfield, Illinois, in urging Cardinal Cupich to reconsider giving Senator Durbin a Lifetime Achievement Award ... given his long record of supporting legal abortion."

Other bishops echoed the concerns. Bishop James Johnston of Kansas City-St. Joseph said the decision "cannot be reconciled with Catholic Social and Moral teaching" and would "give a confusing counter-witness about the dignity of the human

person and the grave evil of destroying innocent human life." Retired Archbishop Joseph Naumann of Kansas City, Kansas, a former head of the USCCB's pro-life committee, labeled the award a "source of scandal" and "pastoral neglect," adding: "Dialogue does not require giving awards to Catholic political leaders who disregard the most fundamental of human rights, the right to life of the unborn."

Durbin's record includes votes against the Partial-Birth Abortion Ban Act, the Pain-Capable Unborn Child Protection Act and the Born-Alive Abortion Survivors Protection Act, as well as support for legislation to codify abortion rights up to birth.

Illinois Right to Life President Mary Kate Zander condemned the planned award as "an explicitly inconsistent and un-Catholic choice," warning it "causes scandal among the faithful by creating confusion" and risks Durbin's soul by failing to hold him accountable. John Breen, a board member of the Catholic Conference of Illinois and a Loyola University Chicago law professor, sought to address the issue at a canceled board meeting, calling Durbin "the poster child for the 'inconsistent ethic of life.'"

Breen said: "All of our work is premised upon the dignity of the human person. And yet you're going to honor a man who denies the dignity of a whole class of persons? It makes no sense." Bill Donohue, president of the Catholic League for Religious and Civil Rights, issued an open letter urging Durbin to decline, noting: "There has never been an abortion he couldn't justify; his voting record on other matters is also in opposition to core Catholic teachings."

Cupich countered that the award was meant to foster dialogue, per 2021 Vatican guidance, and could prompt reflection on interconnected issues. "It could be an invitation to Catholics who fiercely defend the vulnerable on the border between the United States and Mexico to ponder why the Church defends the vulnerable on the border between life and death, as in cases of abortion and euthanasia," he said.

The controversy, which prompted statements from bishops including Michael Olson of Fort Worth, Texas; James Conley of Nebraska; David Ricken of Wisconsin; Carl Kemme of Kansas; and James Wall of Gallup, New Mexico, has fueled calls for renewed unity as the bishops prepare to choose new leaders.

Pro-life advocates, pointing to an estimated 89,770 abortions in Illinois last year and 66 million nationwide since 1973, view the elections as a pivotal moment to reinforce the church's unwavering stance against abortion as the preeminent threat to human dignity.

Update to this story: A week later, when asked by a reporter about Trump sending 400 National Guard troops to Chicago in order to help with the clashes between ICE agents and left-wing protestors, Leo said: "I prefer not to comment at this time about political choices within the United States." Maybe the Pope may have learned a lesson and not comment on issues in the United States.

The Abortion Pill Is Harmful to Women

The abortion pill, easily sold over the counter at the local drug store or shipped out by mail, causes traumatic adverse effects for the women who take it. Yet the federal government lauds the pill as safe. Pro-abortion advocates call it “safe as Tylenol,” despite overwhelming evidence showing otherwise. As a dad of four and a grandpa of seven, fighting for Montana families is my top priority. This includes Montana’s mothers and the most vulnerable: babies in the womb.



Sadly, the culture of life in America has degraded. The abortion pill (mifepristone) is today’s most common form of abortion, accounting for 63 percent of all abortions in the U.S. in 2023. There is evidence that proves mifepristone is not safe, with numerous women reporting experiences of hemorrhaging, sepsis, and infection. But because of lies pushed by pro-abortion advocates, what was once looked at as taboo is now performed on demand at any cost, flaunted, and even deemed a triumphant advance of our society.

By repeating these claims, the very people who claim to care about women’s health endanger the lives of countless women in Montana and throughout the country.

A new study by the Ethics and Public Policy Center (EPPC) assessed the health insurance claims of 865,727 mifepristone prescriptions from 2017-2023. The insurance claims showed that nearly 11 percent of women who used mifepristone experienced serious adverse effects. This is 22 times higher than the Food and Drug Administration (FDA) estimates. The data is a reflection of real-world insurance claims from real women who have used mifepristone. Clearly, the evidence shows this pill can have devastating impacts.

Unfortunately, the *Helena Independent Record* ignored these facts in a recent article and instead chose to use pro-abortion sources to denounce this evidence from EPPC as “flawed.” By doing so, they misrepresent the dangers of the abortion pill to thousands of Montana women.

Despite the undeniable evidence that there are significant medical risks surrounding mifepristone, the FDA during the

Biden administration removed many of the safeguards and warnings. In 2000, the FDA required three in-person doctor appointments for mifepristone. Today none are required. Pills can be dispensed by mail and sold at drugstores like Walgreens and CVS without any medical oversight.

Reducing the abortion pill drug to a simple drug store-accessible medicine presents a clear danger to women, which is why I am calling for the Trump administration to re-evaluate the safety of the abortion pill and reinstate safeguards surrounding its use. These deadly drugs should not be available over the counter or online without any doctor’s care. Ensuring the safety of women and the reliability of products approved by the FDA is something that all parties should agree on.

I am encouraged by President Trump and U.S. Health and Human Services Secretary Robert F. Kennedy’s promises to look into this issue, and I’ll continue to work with the administration to protect women and fight for the most vulnerable in our society.

I am confident that with continued advocacy about the dangers of mifepristone coupled with the efforts of pro-life groups across Montana, we will once again return to a point where our culture respects the dignity in every life, born and unborn, and where abortion is unthinkable.

If Planned Parenthood was killing puppies instead of babies, America would have shut them down by now.

Pro-Life Pregnancy Centers are Helping More Pregnant Women Than Ever Before

In 2025, a quiet but powerful shift is happening across the United States: more women than ever are seeking life-affirming support during unexpected pregnancies. At Heartbeat International, an international network of pregnancy help organizations, our 24/7 **Option Line** contact center has connected with more than 750,000 women already this year alone—nearly double the anticipated annual volume.

Women call, text, and chat to get information, counseling, and practical resources, and their experiences reveal a simple truth: when women know they have support, they make life-affirming choices.

Established in 2003, Option Line is the only **fully staffed**, bilingual pro-life contact center in the U.S., connecting women with their local pregnancy help organization.

Option Line provides consultation on abortion, adoption, and parenting, and schedules appointments in real-time through a state-of-the-art system, helping women get the help they need in the moment as well as long-term support at their local pregnancy help organization.

This surge in demand reflects a growing need for practical help and compassionate guidance.

One mother told our team, “I just want you to know that you saved me tonight. If you hadn’t picked up the phone, I don’t know what would have happened to me, and I thank you for that.”

Another shared, “I thought I could go through with it [the abortion] but once I was in the abortion clinic I walked out. I never wanted to have an abortion but felt pressured and felt I

had no choice. I am glad I have your number.” These stories are not abstract statistics – they are daughters, sisters, and mothers navigating difficult decisions under pressure. They remind us that choice is meaningful only when women have real options.

The trend extends to women who have begun a chemical abortion and seek to reverse it.

The **Abortion Pill Rescue® Network**, which connects women with healthcare providers who can administer progesterone therapy in early-stage chemical abortions, has grown from 150 new starts per month last year to over 200 per month this year. One mother reflected on the reversal **saving her son**: “He was the piece I never knew I was missing, and I can’t imagine life without him.”

Another said simply, “We picked up the progesterone, and the rest is history. It was the best decision ever.”

These stories show that timely medical care combined with compassionate counseling can create genuine second chances. The implications of this surge reach beyond individual stories.

Policymakers and healthcare providers must ask whether women are being given access to comprehensive support at the moments they need it most. Evidence from programs like Option Line and the Abortion Pill Rescue® demonstrates that when women are provided with guidance, counseling, and practical help, many choose to carry their pregnancies to term, with lasting benefits for families and communities.

This rise in contacts may even reflect a cultural shift: women are no longer silently navigating crises alone. They are actively seeking help, exploring alternatives, and exercising agency in their decision-making.

One mother who reached out through Option Line shared, “I’ve been thinking a lot about everything, and I’ve decided I’m going to keep the baby.”

Her story, like thousands of others, illustrates the impact that access to life-affirming support can have.

In a country often consumed by polarized debates over “re-productive rights,” these numbers and stories provide an important perspective. Women are reaching out. Lives are being changed. And when society responds with compassion, practical support, and accessible resources, more mothers carry their pregnancies to term, and more children are welcomed into loving homes.
